



Pushing Back Against Mandates

After years of hyper and hurried mandates regarding Electric Vehicles (EV), Battery Electric Vehicles (BEV), Self-Driving or Driverless Vehicles and their suggested benefits toward the environment and the future of the planet, some moderation is happening. To begin, the State of Connecticut has withdrawn from its original position of joining the CARB Mandate, requiring passenger vehicles to be electric by 2035. After receiving bipartisan resistance, Connecticut Governor Ned Lamont withdrew the Mandate Proposal after four months of consideration.

3000 Auto Dealers, representing nearly every major brand and all 50 states, have sent a letter to President Biden asking his administration to "tap the brakes" on the push toward BEVs. The mandates are leading to inventory that consumers are not buying.

Motorcyclist Advisory Council Being Established!

Monday morning, after nearly two years of delay, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) announced the initial steps to establish the Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC). In November of 2021, Congress passed, and President Biden signed the



Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. Included in the law was reformation of the MAC. The Mac will coordinate with and advise the Secretary of Transportation, the National hzighway Traffic Safety Admistration (NHTSA) Administrator, and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Administrator on transportation issues of concern to motorcyclists, including motorcycle and motorcyclist safety; barrier and road design, construction, and maintenance practices; and the architecture and implementation of intelligent transportation system technologies. As stated in the announcement, "The MAC seeks to have a fairly balanced membership with expertise in motorcycle and motorcyclist safety, highway engineering, and safety analysis." Of the 13 seats open on the MAC, "One shall be a representative of a national motorcyclist foundation." The Motorcycle Riders Foundation looks forward to putting qualified candidates forward to fill not only this designated seat but other seats on the board as well.

Nominations are due by December 15, 2023. If you would like to read more about the MAC, it's mission, and its membership.

The MRF would like to thank all lawmakers in Washington D.C. who fought for the creation and establishment of the MAC. Special thanks to the 13 Members of the House of Representatives who sent this letter to USDOT in May.





24 Message From Our Pastor

Dear Fellow ABATE Members,

Have You Ever Been Loaned a Motorcycle?

Have you ever been loaned a motorcycle? How about a motorcycle for a 10 day trip?

About 15 years ago, my brother Chris (may he rest in peace), my son, and my grandson planned and executed a trip up the Atlantic east coast. It included the Outer Banks, ferry rides in North Carolina, Kitty Hawk, and the Tail of the Dragon! It was one of those motorcycle trips of a lifetime and family bonding.

To pull it off, we needed to borrow one more motorcycle, than the ones we already possessed. A family member loaned a scoot to my brother, and my brother loaned his motorcycle to my son. Think of how unselfish these acts of loaning thousands of dollars' worth of scoots (very nice Harleys) with no strings attached! However, think of the amount of responsibility and stewardship is on the ones who have borrowed the bikes!

Stewardship, in the Oxford Dictionary means, "...the job of super vising or taking care of something, such as an organization or property." Another definition from Dictionary.com is, "The responsible overseeing and protection of something worth caring for and preserving."

Do you realize that God has given us responsibility and stewardship of ourselves? We are not our own. We have been bought for a price! What we have is really on loan. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 in the Amplified Bible says, "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is within you, whom you have

[received as a gift] from God, and that you are not your own [property]? ²⁰ You were bought with a price [you were actually purchased with the precious blood of Jesus and made His own]. So then, honor and glorify God with your body." Romans 14:12 says, "So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God." – KJV

It came naturally to take excellent care of the borrowed motorcycles. What about your life and your soul?
