

Pushing Back Against Mandates

After years of hyper and hurried mandates regarding Electric Vehicles (EV), Battery Electric Vehicles (BEV), Self-Driving or Driverless Vehicles and their suggested benefits toward the environment and the future of the planet, some moderation is happening. To begin, the State of Connecticut has withdrawn from its original position of joining the CARB Mandate, requiring passenger vehicles to be electric by 2035. After receiving bipartisan resistance, Connecticut Governor Ned Lamont withdrew the Mandate Proposal after four months of consideration.

Motorcyclist Advisory Council Being Established!

Monday morning, after nearly two years of delay, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) announced the initial steps to establish the Motorcyclist Advisory Council (MAC). In November of 2021, Congress passed, and President Biden signed the



Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. Included in the law was reformation of the MAC. The Mac will coordinate with and advise the Secretary of Transportation, the National hzighway Traffic Safety Admistration (NHTSA) Administrator, and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Administrator on transportation issues of concern to motorcyclists, including motorcycle and motorcyclist safety; barrier and road design, construction, and maintenance practices; and the architecture and implementation of intelligent transportation system technologies. As stated in the announcement, "The MAC seeks to have a fairly balanced membership with expertise in motorcycle and motorcyclist safety, highway engineering, and safety analysis." Of the 13 seats open on the MAC, "One shall be a representative of a national motorcyclist foundation." The Motorcycle Riders Foundation looks forward to putting qualified candidates forward to fill not only this designated seat but other seats on the board as well.

Nominations are due by December 15, 2023. If you would like to read more about the MAC, it's mission, and its membership.

The MRF would like to thank all lawmakers in Washington D.C. who fought for the creation and establishment of the MAC. Special thanks to the 13 Members of the House of Representatives who sent this letter to USDOT in May.



Never Run Out of Gas! Here's How...

Most bikers have one thing that most cagers do not. It's the RESERVE fuel switch, that is usually located on the lower left side of the fuel tank. We cannot recall how many times we've been riding in a group to see one bike momentarily drop back. Then, we see the rider reach down, flip the switch/valve, and immediately return to the group.

There are some other things bikers can do to help from running out:

Correct tire pressure

Starting out with a full tank and fill up before hitting the reserve

Staying tuned up

Not overloading

Slow down

Utilizing your cruise control

Life can seem likes it's sucking the fuel which provides the energy to keep us going. We can easily burn out. It can happen in a way in which it is too late and, it seems we're stuck on the side of the road. It seems like instead of the correct pressure, there is too much pressure. As things get progressively worse, we feel overloaded.

In Matthew 11:28-30, Jesus says, "Come to me, all of you who are tired from carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke and put it on you, and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit; and you will find rest. For the yoke I will give you


