

LEGISLATIVE REPORT- MARCH 2022

TALLAHASSEE --- The legal battle started in 2017 after St. Johns County's Nease High School required transgender male student Drew Adams to use girls' bathrooms or a gender-neutral, single-stall bathroom. Now, nearly five years later, a full federal appeals court is poised to consider arguments about whether the Northeast Florida school district violated Adams' rights by preventing him from using boys' bathrooms.

The case, which will be heard Tuesday by the 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Atlanta, has drawn national attention. The U.S. Department of Justice will argue in favor of Adams, who also has received support from 22 states and the District of Columbia. Meanwhile, 18 states have backed the St. Johns County School Board's position.

A district judge and a three-judge panel of the appeals court ruled in favor of Adams. But the full appeals court vacated the panel ruling and said it would hear the case.

The Justice Department contends that the school board's refusal to allow Adams to use boys' bathrooms violated equal-protection rights and a federal law known as Title IX, which bars sex-based discrimination.

"The board fails to identify any sound basis for treating Adams differently than cisgender boys for purposes of using the school restrooms, even while treating him as a boy for other purposes," the Justice Department said in a brief filed in November. "As the district court found, Adams identifies and presents physically as a boy. Even if Adams has some anatomical differences from cisgender boys, those differences are not observable when Adams goes into a private bathroom stall and closes the door. To justify differential treatment, the differences must actually be relevant to the government's (the school board's) asserted justification."

But attorneys for the school board have pointed to privacy issues in defending the bathroom policy. Adams graduated from the high school as the case moved forward.

"This case has always been about whether a definition of sex founded in the real and enduring biological differences between boys and girls substantially advances the important privacy interests of students to use the bathroom free from members of the opposite biological sex," the school board's attorneys wrote in one court document.

Democrats likely will pepper Republican leaders with questions about issues such as a proposal to shift \$200 million away from school districts that required students last year to wear masks during the COVID-19 pandemic.

But the budget discussion likely will be just a warmup. The House is scheduled later Tuesday to consider a bill (HB 5) that would prohibit doctors from performing abortions after 15 weeks of pregnancy. Abortion issues always spark heavy debate, but this year's proposal — modeled after a Mississippi law that is under review at the U.S. Supreme Court — would place a major restriction on abortions.

As of Friday afternoon, Democrats had filed 17 proposed amendments to the bill. Few, if any, of the amendments likely will pass. But that doesn't mean the debate will cool down.

A House panel Thursday will take up a package that would provide a wide range of tax breaks but does not include Gov. Ron DeSantis' big-ticket proposal to suspend the state's gasoline tax for five months.

The House Ways & Means Committee will consider a bill (PCB WMC 22-01) that includes 14-day sales tax "holidays" in May on gear for the hurricane season and in late July on back-to-school items such as clothes, school supplies and personal computers.

The bill also would bring back a "Freedom Week" tax holiday around Independence Day. During that period, shoppers could avoid paying sales taxes on tickets to music events, sporting events, movies, theaters, parks, fairs and museums, purchases of items for camping, fishing and boating and purchases of surf-boards, canoes, kayaks and bicycles.

A new tax holiday would go for seven days around Labor Day for purchases of items including work boots, power tools, toolboxes for vehicles and LED flashlights. With the state's coffers brimming from federal stimulus money and higher-than-expected tax collections, the House and Senate ultimately will have to agree on a final package of tax cuts. But both chambers, at least so far, have not embraced DeSantis' proposal to suspend the 25-cent-a-gallon gas tax for five months starting in July. The package also includes temporary tax exemptions for impact-resistant windows, doors and garage doors for residential properties; children's books; baby and toddler clothing, shoes and diapers; and Energy Star certified refrigerators, water heaters and washers and dryers.

State Chief Financial Officer Jimmy Patronis called the proposal for impact-resistant windows, doors and garage doors "a practical way of saving folks money while incentivizing homeowners to better protect their homes from hurricanes" that "in some cases" could reduce insurance costs.



Dear Fellow ABATE Members,

Ignoring the Warning Signs and Catastrophic Consequences

Most of us, who are reading this, fully understand and know the warning signs that will lead to catastrophic failures of our motorcycles. Included are: balding and unbalanced tires; low or high oil pressure and levels; fluid leaks; abnormal fuel consumption; unfamiliar noises; gas and/or burning smells, etc..

Almost 3 years ago, we were deployed as disaster relief volunteers, into a flooded three-county area of Southeast Texas, just a few miles north of the border. Little did we know, the actual temperatures of the area we were to work in, would range from 102 degrees Fahrenheit to 106 degrees each day. Several of our co-workers suffered severe heat exhaustion, within a week of our arrival. If it had progressed into heat strokes, it could have been fatal. They either did not know the warning signs and/or ignored them. They obviously failed to take precautionary measures!

As Chaplains, we provide a lot of emotional and spiritual care in dealing with stress. Let's look at a scripture to illustrate stress in the end times. From the reading of following scripture, perhaps you will agree we are in the end times? Is there is anything that sounds familiar? 2 Timothy 3:1-3 (this is from the Amplified Bible, translated after the 1930's) "But understand this, that in the last days will come (set in) perilous times of great stress and trouble [hard to deal with and hard to bear]. For people will be lovers of self and [utterly] self-centered, lovers of money and aroused by an inordinate [greedy] desire for wealth, proud and arrogant and contemptuous boasters. They will be abusive (blasphemous, scoffing), disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy and profane. [They will be] without natural [human] affection (callous and inhuman), relentless (admitting of no truce or appeasement); [they will be] slanderers (false accusers, troublemakers), intemperate and loose in morals and conduct, uncontrolled and fierce, haters of good." This was written almost 2,000 years ago.

The Bible tells us many stories about God's warnings. It also tells us about those who heeded God's warnings, were spared dire consequences. God has always provided a means of escape. Whether you know God, if you are religious, or if you don't know God at all, you can look at the story of Noah and the Ark (Hebrews 11:7). How about the story of Jonah and the Big Fish, where Jonah ended up warning the people of Nineveh? (Jonah 3) The great story of the Passover... (Exodus 12)


