14 LEGISLATIVE REPORT

LEGISLATIVE REPORT- OCTOBER 2021

TALLAHASSEE --- Legal wrangling in courts this week set up showdowns over some of Gov. Ron DeSantis' top priorities, as the state fights on numerous fronts to uphold some of this year's most contentious efforts.

On Thursday, Chief U.S. District Judge Mark Walker blocked a controversial state law that enhances penalties and creates new crimes in protests that turn violent.

DeSantis championed the measure after nationwide protests focused on racial justice following the death last year of George Floyd, a Black man who was killed by a Minneapolis police officer. Republican lawmakers approved the measure, dubbed the "Combatting Public Disorder" act, during the 2021 legislative session and DeSantis signed it this Spring.

TALLAHASSEE --- As legislators start the once-a-decade political redistricting process next week, a national group released polling data Thursday indicating most Floridians are opposed to "gerrymandering," even if it helps their party gain seats.

And the majority of the 428 registered voters who were polled have concerns about lawmakers getting to draw new political lines for their own districts, according to Joe Kabourek, senior campaign director for Massachusetts-based RepresentUS, a nonprofit trying to limit the influence of money in American politics.TALLAHASSEE --- Pencils down, class. Time's up.

"High-stakes" standardized testing looks like it will be put out to pasture in Florida, but it's a move that will have to be executed by state lawmakers next year.

Gov. Ron DeSantis on Tuesday announced a proposal to end the Florida Standards Assessments, a plan that is is almost certain to be one of the governor's top priorities for the legislative session that kicks off in January.

"We are going to be ending that, and we are going to be replacing it with progress monitoring, which many school districts are doing anyway. This is short, individualized check-in assessments three times per year. This will take hours, not days, to be able to do these assessments," DeSantis told reporters during a press conference in Doral.

DeSantis said the proposal would lead to assessing students in the fall, winter and spring, which would reduce the amount of time spent each year on testing. The state Department of Education said the proposed system will be dubbed Florida's Assessment of Student Thinking, or F.A.S.T.

TALLAHASSEE --- Senate Reapportionment Chairman Ray Rodrigues said Monday he wants the Florida Legislature to avoid the "shadow process" that occurred in 2012 when lawmakers drew new political district lines that were rejected by the Florida Supreme Court.

The Estero Republican said changes have been implemented to avoid another battle with the court and that the public will be able to provide input on how congressional and legislative lines should be shifted.

But, as the once-a-decade redistricting process kicks off in the Capitol this week, no decision has been made on whether lawmakers will travel around the state or even hold virtual forums to gather input from Floridians on prospective boundary changes.

Senator Targets Confederate Holidays Sep 17, 2021

A proposal that would end legal holidays marking the birthdays of Confederate Gen. Robert E. Lee and Confederate President Jefferson Davis, along with Confederate Memorial Day, has been revived in the Florida Senate. The measure (SB 250), filed Friday by Senate Minority Leader Sen. Lauren Book. D-Plantation. would also do away with statutory protections for Confederate flags and emblems. State law makes it unlawful for people and companies to sell or advertise merchandise that includes either Florida's state flag or emblem or any of the flags or emblems used by the Confederate States. Included in the ban are the flags and emblems used by the "military or naval forces of the Confederate States at any time within the years 1860 to 1865." The law notes that Confederate flags and other items can be used for "decorative or patriotic purposes." Lee's birthday, Jan. 19, and Confederate Memorial Day, April 26, have been legal holidays in Florida since 1895. Davis' June 3 birthday was added in 1905. The three Confederate holidays are not paid holidays for public employees in the Sunshine State, however. Florida is one of five states that have kept Confederate Memorial Day a legal holiday. Book filed the proposal for consideration during the 2022 legislative session, which will begin Jan. 11. In past sessions, similar proposals have drawn objections from people who argued the changes would erase Southern history.





Dear Fellow ABATE Members,

Road Rage Victim or Perpetrator?

Several months ago, while we were over in the Miami area, a cager attempted to run someone down on his scoot! The same day (and/ or close to it), a driver was shooting at another driver due to an accidental cut-off incident. Road rage incidents seem to be increasing, as society seems to be becoming more polarized and frustrated with politics, personal issues, along with the ongoing pandemic, etc...

Because we are physically more vulnerable while on a motorcycle, being the victim or perpetrator of road rage could easily turn out to be fatal and/or permanently life altering. It could happen to you and/or your passenger.

We deal with a lot of things on the road easily causing our indignation:

- -Texting/cell phones Many times they cause impediment of traffic by driving too slow, not moving when the light turns green, weaving in and out of their lane, etc...
- -Aggressive drivers Weaving in and out of lanes at high speeds, sometimes "racing" another driver doing the same things, etc...
- -Heavy traffic that causes everyone aggravation...

Before riding, check any issues bothering you. Many times, the things that may cause one to explode, have been building up inside for a period of time and it only takes one little spark/incident to cause ignition!

When you are caught in a situation, follow the scripture in James 1:19-20, "Understand this, my beloved brothers and sisters.

Let everyone be quick to hear [be a careful, thoughtful listener], slow to speak [a speaker of carefully chosen words and], slow to anger [patient, reflective, forgiving]; for the [resentful, deep-seated] anger of man does not produce the righteousness

of God [that standard of behavior which He requires from us]" (AMP)

Ecclesiastes 7:9 says, "Do not be quick in spirit to be angry or vexed, for anger and vexation lodge in the bosom of fools." (AMPC)

Put this into your heart and always remember, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law." Galatians 5:22-23 (NKJV)


If you prayed that prayer for the very first time and you have accepted Jesus into your heart, we would like to know and help you along your journey of faith.


