## NORTH ZONE MIDDLE SCHOOL CHOIR SOLO & ENSEMBLE GUIDELINES

## (updated 8/26/20)

- 1. As a guide, use the high school rules found at: <u>https://www.uiltexas.org/policy/constitution/music/solo-ensemble</u>
- 2. Judges must be given an original score (no copies)
- 3. Maximum entry per student is two solo/small ensemble and one medium ensemble.
- 4. Majority of any ensemble performing the same piece must be new personnel (51%) from previous year to current year AND within same year (if 2 ensembles entered from school are performing the same piece, they may only share 49% of the students).
- 5. All pieces must be performed as written (perform a capella if written as only a capella)
- 6. Solos
  - a. All solos must be memorized
  - b. All solos must be accompanied
  - c. If a selection <u>not</u> in the PML is better suited for an individual, the selection should be comparable in difficulty to the Grade 3 material found in the PML.
  - d. all selections not from the PML should be classified as Grade 3 on the entry
- 7. Small Ensembles
  - a. If a selection <u>not</u> in the PML is better suited for an ensemble, the selection should be comparable in difficulty to the Grade 3 material found in the PML.
  - b. all selections not from the PML should be classified as Grade 3 on the entry
  - c. small ensembles my use up to 3 on a part or 6 singers maximum if unison
- 8. Medium Ensembles
  - a. Must have a minimum of 10 members and a maximum of 24 members
  - b. All selections <u>not</u> from the PML should be comparable to Grade 3.
  - c. all selections not from the PML should be classified as Grade 3 on the entry
  - d. A medium ensemble may not perform a selection that was performed by a similar medium ensemble from the same school in the previous year, unless at least half the members of the group did not participate in the medium ensemble the previous year.
  - e. A medium ensemble may not perform a selection that is also being performed by any or all of the ensemble members as a small ensemble.
  - f. A medium ensemble may not perform a selection that is performed in a UIL organization event during the current school year.
  - g. No unison pieces; must be at least two-part.
  - h. Song may be a capella or accompanied
- 9. Limitations Each student may enter two events which may consist of:
  - a. A vocal solo and a vocal small ensemble, or
  - b. Two vocal small ensembles provided they are different voicings, different music is performed, and the majority of ensemble members are different.
  - c. In addition, students may enter a medium ensemble
