- 1. Poster Title (Clear, concise, and reflective of the project or topic)**
- 2. Author(s) and Credentials**
 - Name(s):
 - Affiliation(s):
 - Contact Email:
- 3. Learning Objectives (Must be Measurable; use action verbs)**

Example

By the end of this poster presentation, participants will be able to:

- Identify barriers to fruit and vegetable access in rural communities.
- Describe a mobile market intervention model.
- Analyze the outcomes of the pilot project on WIC participant redemption rates.

- 4. Content Outline/Poster Content**

You may structure your e-poster as follows:

- Introduction/Background
- Purpose/Objectives
- Methods
- Results/Findings
- Conclusions
- References (APA style preferred)

- 5. Disclosure Statement**

All poster presenters must disclose relevant financial or non-financial relationships.

Examples:

- “The author(s) of this poster have no relevant financial or non-financial relationships to disclose.”

- “Jane Doe has received grant funding from XYZ to support the development of this project.”

6. Interactive Component (Must have One or More Components)

Examples:

- Live Q&A
- Downloadable handouts
- Contact info for follow-up questions
- Pre-recorded video narration or tour
