Hello family. I hope this letter finds you well. I hope this letter also brings warmth to your heart as you realize that your support enables us to do what we do.

August was a very busy and blessed month. We made it through it with gladness. We held the two-day camp we had scheduled for the month, with about 50 young people participating. During the event, we shared God's word with them and offered spiritual insight. Most of these young people are not Christians and are unfamiliar with the true gospel. The program included morning services, followed by games and competitions led by the missionaries. The highlight was the dirt trail I had the honor of putting together. They had a lot of fun.

One moment that impacted me was a testimony from one of our fellow missionaries. He had a conversation with a participant who is homosexual. After the first day, he went home and started drinking, then came back in the evening drunk and wanted to talk. He said that everything said throughout the day really spoke to his heart and that he was tired of fighting sin. We will follow up with him and bring him closer to Jesus. Pray for him; his name is Renato.

We had a lot of work to organize and to get everyone to participate, from food and worship to sermons, games, and materials. It was not hard because we were doing it for Jesus. He loves these people and wants them to know him.

After the camps, we had the chance to do another VBS program called "Campeão". About 40 kids came and listened to the story about forgiveness. The local church where we attend on Sunday came along and donated some candies and popcorn. We bought little gifts like pencils and cookies, put everything in a bag, and handed them out after the program. They loved it.

It has been a privilege to serve in this place and to witness what God can do in other people's lives. We are amazed at how little can have such a great impact. We are confident that God will continue to open doors as we advance the gospel of Jesus in these places.

As I write this people are remembering the 09/11 tragedy all over the world. And all I can think of is how this world needs Jesus, and how we need to do our best to bring the light to the darkest corners of this earth.

Let's remember those who lost their lives because others didn't have the light of the world whom he gave his life for them all.

WHAT'S NEXT?

As I write this, Jahvona is at a women's conference for about a week. As soon as she arrives, I am leaving the same day for training at our base in Itacoatiara, a 6-hour drive from here. Then I have some teaching to do at the church where we are attending. Then we have a kids' day camp scheduled for October 12th. Pray that many kids can come to hear about the love of Jesus.

From now on, we must plan according to the river level. By November, we likely won't reach the villages we serve due to low water for navigation. This will allow us to work on upcoming projects. Renan will research for our team over the next few weeks, visiting villages to identify which are "reached," "unreached," or "barely reached." We need data on names and locations. He also plans to visit the Manacapuru River to determine its position relative to the gospel.

Please pray that Jesus may be known in every single action we do as a team in this immense area. And thank you for your faithful support. Be blessed. The Olimprios

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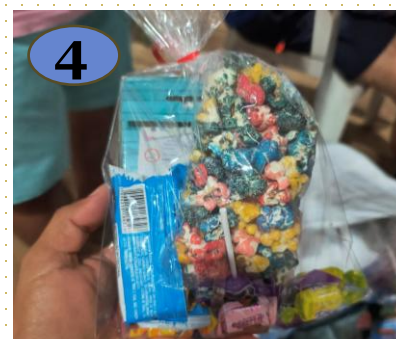
