"I am Eluane, and this is my story:

I grew up in a christian environment, where my mom was a believer and dad wasn't. Later on, my dad decided to follow Jesus with us. Therefore, I learned from the Word of God and got in contact with SEARA missionaries that came to our village. I had a very difficult moment in my life when I decided to engage in a relationship with a non-christian man, which led to an early pregnancy. A lot of people and missionaries had talked to me about not making wrong decisions and being rebellious, but I sought my own way of life. Then we figure it would be best to get married. Life became very challenging after marrying someone that didn't believe the same thing and didn't like Christian and much less missionaries. But we had a turn around.

My husband started to hear and enjoy the word of God after becoming good friend with Renan Olimpio, our missionary, and he is now following Jesus. So did I with Jahvona Olimpio who was a source of encouragement and guidance while I struggle with my family challenges. Every time we needed help, they were there for us, and I love them as part of my family.

Many times, I thought about giving up, but God helped me to be strong and to seek for restauration and keep my family together. I have been through ups and downs, but now growing along side my family and my church in Tapira."
