Hello, dear family!

March held many surprises for us and filled us with excitement to go down to Brazil for the next assignment.

Our family was able to connect with many supporters and to invite others to join us. Every moment with our sponsors was very special, filled with good conversations and prayers. We are extremely blessed to have so many godly men and women in our team. One blessing I would like to share is that more people have joined our team this month. Some I never met in person to talk about ministry, and some we met once at church. I am always amazed at how God brings people to us that we never thought about. I don't know how God moves other people's hearts to start supporting us, but I know he puts us together for a purpose.

As I am writing this, our project funds are at 80%! Can you believe that? God has amazingly blessed us through individuals and businesses. In our personal support, we are at 95%. That would be enough reason to praise him all day long. We feel very loved and supported by all of you who have faithfully given and prayed for our family.

Our last few weeks in the US have been busy scheduling meetings with the few sponsors that we haven't met yet. We know that these last few days can get crazy when people know we're leaving soon. Meanwhile, we started packing 2 weeks before our flights, so we could do a little bit each day and clean the house we were staying in this whole time. Mercy Hill Church blessed us beyond measure by allowing us to stay at their guest house for no cost, and everyone was extremely thoughtful in caring for our family.

We thank everyone who has been supporting us by donating, praying, lending a car, stopping by to say hi, babysitting, inviting us over for supper and games, taking us out to eat, and introducing us to new people and churches. I could add a lot more to this list, given how many people have made our lives so much brighter. All of this reminded me of the scriptures that summarize what we feel in the face of all the love we have received:

What's ahead?

Our packing adventure has officially begun. We'll be flying out to Brazil on April 7th, and we will be enduring a 16h trip with lots of luggage and curious little ones. We enjoy the trip because we know what awaits us. As soon as we get to Manaus, we will rent a vehicle and spend 3 days in Manacapuru looking at a couple of houses from Facebook Marketplace. From there, we will head to the base, where we'll rest and organize our belongings. That's a preparation for our move to Manacapuru. We need to take our boat to the mechanic for a check-up and make sure everything is still working. Renan will be going back and forth between Manaus and Manacapuru to handle the process of finding a car and housing. As soon as we get all of those set, then we move to the new location and spend one month establishing ourselves in the new house. We will have to find all the furniture and appliances for this new place. We hope that the process goes smoothly and that no one goes crazy. Jahvona and the kids will be at the base for the most part, and the kids will enjoy the pool and the other missionaries' kids who live there.

We couldn't be more thankful to all of you who have prayed for and supported us throughout this time in the US. Keep us in your prayers as we fly and get busy with ministry preparation. I can't wait to share all about it next month. Be blessed.
