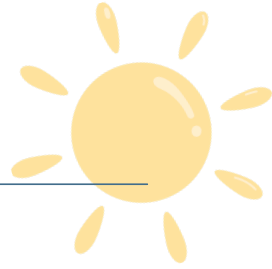

Opening our doors, sharing our work

Conard House recently welcomed a cohort of 30 professionals from across the United States as part of the Housing First Partners Conference, hosting a site visit at the Jordan. The visit offered an opportunity to share our model of supportive housing and community-based care, and to provide a closer look at how our programs are implemented in practice through daily operations, resident engagement, and integrated services that support long-term stability.

More importantly, the tour created space for meaningful dialogue and connection. It became an opportunity to foster healthy partnerships and exchange ideas with others committed to advancing Housing First approaches. These conversations lay the groundwork for future collaboration and projects that can strengthen and expand the impact of our work, reinforcing the importance of shared learning in addressing complex community needs.

Since becoming a resident of the Jordan in 2019, Matthew Miyaki's journey has been shaped by both profound loss and meaningful support. After losing a partner of nineteen years, Matthew found stability through Conard House—receiving support that made it possible to stay grounded, rebuild connection, and begin moving forward again. With that support, and the companionship of Windy, Matthew has found a renewed sense of purpose and a place that truly feels like home.
