
# Sponsorship Opportunities

Since 2014, our nonprofit organization, Safe Exit Initiative, has served communities throughout Massachusetts by supporting individuals with histories of commercial sexual exploitation. Our programs are built by and for those who know the ugly realities of exploitation first-hand- people with lived and living experience in the sex trade and sex trafficking. We provide essential resources, specialized programming, and facilitate community connections daily. Through outreach and advocacy programs, we facilitate opportunities for survivors to navigate their pathways on their own terms to safety and healing, exiting the sex trade, and rebuilding their lives.

The demand for SEI's services continues to grow. The sex trade is a multi-billion-dollar business that profits off the exploitation of the most vulnerable and marginalized in our communities. We cannot do this alone.
