Seeds of Life Series: Torah the Seeds for Life

The Remembering Seed

Introduction

This week we see the seed still in Israel and we see how Yehovah protects His people where they are. What lesson can we learn from that? We can learn that wherever you are Yehovah can protect you and He can watch over you. Just look at the children of Israel and where they are! This is fascinating because we often doubt that Yehovah can protect us wherever we are. Remember Yehovah is over the earth. We shouldn't struggle with this.

The Firstborn that is consecrated

Exodus 13:1-2

1. The firstborn are to be consecrated to Yehovah first
2. Yeshua was consecrated by Yosef and Mariam in (Luke 2:28-33).
3. Yeshua's parents followed the Torah to the letter on these matters and so should we.

Remember this Day

Exodus 13:3-4

1. Yehovah told us while we partake in the Pesach meal we are to remember this DAY.
Zachor Hazey!
2. Yehovah continues to remind us to remember important things in the Scripture.
3. Yehovah delivered Israel by a strong hand! NO hametz is to be eaten. "For by strength of hand the Lord brought you out from this place, in such haste that there could or should be no leavened bread eaten." Which is paraphrased.

Reminder of Unleavened Bread

Exodus 13:5-7

1. When Yehovah brings you into the land of your ancestors where the Canaanites are you are to remember this service.
2. What are we to remember? We are to remember The Feast of Unleavened Bread because it is a feast of remembrance.
3. No Chametz is to be seen in our borders which is a representative of sin.

Between Your Eyes

Exodus 13:8-10

1. Tell your children what happened in Egypt. Lesson: Tell our children about the wonders of Elohim. Part of the Shema
2. It will be a sign on your hand and between your eyes. Part of the Shema
3. We are to keep this ordinance throughout all of our generations.

Another Reminder to Your Son

Exodus 13:14-16

1. Yehovah told us to tell our sons about what happened in Egypt.
2. Again they will be frontlets between your eyes and like a sign on your hand.
3. With a strong Hand He brought our ancestors out!

Take Away

1. The Firstborn is consecrated to Yehovah because they are the first dedicated.
2. We are to not have Chametz in your borders at all throughout your generations. Chametz is representative of sin.
3. Yehovah delivered His people out of Egypt with a strong hand and outstretched arm.

Application

1. I will thank Yehovah that we are consecrated unto Yehovah as a follower of Yeshua.
2. I will continue to keep the chametz out of my life so that I will not be spoiled in spirit.
3. I will continue to be thankful that Yeshua has delivered us from our sins with a strong hand and outstretched arm.
