ROSH CHODESH

FAST DAY
Every 1st Tuesday through Wednesday, from sundown to sundown (S25) or from dinner to dinner. Join in prayer for the congregation, our friends & families, our community, our Nation & Israel.

PREP DAY
Prep your Home & Meals for Shabbat. On this day, we clean our homes and cook any meals for the upcoming Sabbath. Any shopping (buying or selling), or banking is also done, as it is forbidden on the Sabbath.
Ex. 16:23, Neh. 10:28-32, 13:15-22

SHABBAT (Rest/No Work Day)
Shabbat is a day of complete rest, where no usual work is done. "But the seventh day is a Shabbat to Yhvh your Elohim. In it you shall not do any work not you, nor your son, your daughter, your male servant, your female servant, your cattle, nor the outsider that is within your gates".
Ex. 16:26, 20:10, 31:14, 35:1-3; Lev. 23:3
