Feast of Unleavened Bread: Seventh Day Convocation Message

The Passover Revival

2 Chronicles 35:1-19

Introduction

Have you ever wondered why so many Christians are celebrating the death, burial and resurrection of Yeshua right now? Could it be this is probably the greatest conspiracy that ever happened on this planet? The conspiracy of HaSatan lying to Christians about their heritage and saying we don't have to keep these feasts because Jesus fulfilled them all except the word fulfilled doesn't mean abolish it means to make perfect or to make more accurate? During the reign of King Josiah Passover was either celebrated in a very small way or it wasn't even being celebrated at all. Baal worship took over and Baal priests said Oh you don't have to worship Yehovah all you have to do is worship Baal bc He is the true god. What did Yehovah ever do for you? Baal gave us freedom to do whatever we want to do without having to follow any commandments all they had was a calendar that was similar to the Canaanite Calendar. What if this chapter is a picture of a worldwide revival where the Body of Messiah starts to celebrate

Passover instead of Easter and all of the other feasts for that matter. Here are the steps to that process.

2 Chronicles 35:1

1. The first step is to return to a basic celebration of Passover like Josiah did
2. He did it on the correct day. Knowing the correct day is also the most important for instance the Passover is always celebrated on a full moon. We typically although not stated in Scripture observe the meal when the moon is at its strongest illumination. Ps. 81:3.
3. The next step eat the Lamb that is the center piece of the whole seder besides the Bitter Herb and the Matzah.

2 Chronicles 35:2

1. He reinstated the Priests to their duties and encouraged them in the service of the House of Yehovah.
2. Pray that the Pastors would get the vision of Passover and the Feasts of the Lord. If we have the Pastors and Elders there can be great break through.
3. Encourage the Pastors in learning about the Feasts of Yehovah. You get the Pastors you get the people.

2 Chronicles 35:3-4

1. Restore Yehovah to His rightful place of worship which is in our hearts right now but eventually back in Jerusalem.
2. Train teachers of the Torah in the Messianic community to also teach the Torah and multiply through healthy multiplication and not through splits and division.
3. Prepare yourselves by your ancestral houses. Simply speaking go back to your spiritual ancestry.

2 Chronicles 35:5-6

1. Assemble yourself in the House of Yehovah. (Heb 10:25).
2. It says to stand in a set apart place. Are you standing in the set apart place right now?
3. Sanctify yourselves, slaughter the Passover lamb and prepare it for your people according to the Word of Yehovah.

2 Chronicles 35:7-8

1. Josiah provided for all the people who were present.
2. What's not to think that Yeshua will not provide for all of those who want to celebrate His Feasts and follow His Torah.

3. The People gave freewill offerings to Yehovah after this.

2 Chronicles 35:10-16

1. The priests prepared the avodah or the service in the exact prescribed way that Yehovah commanded it to be done.
2. according to verse 15 we see that they worshipped Yehovah.
3. Even the gatekeepers were taken care of because the Levites provided for them.

2 Chronicles 35:17-18

1. The children of Israel celebrated the Passover at that time and observed the Feast of Matzot for seven day.
2. We will celebrate the Marriage supper of the Lamb with Yeshua which is a continuation of the Passover but this time with the Lamb. Revelation 19.
3. Passover hadn't been celebrated like Josiah's since the days of Samuel the prophet, and none of the king of Israel had ever celebrated such a Passover as Josiah did with the priests, the Levites, all Judah and Israel who were present and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Take Aways

1. Keep it simple in your celebration of Yehovah's feasts because He just wants your heart.
2. Don't let it get mundane and just stop celebrating all together.
3. Josiah was the only one of the Kings of Israel and Judah to hold a Passover like the one He did in his 18th year.

Application

1. I will live with the anticipation of celebrating my Father's appointed times.
2. I will take these times seriously knowing that they are incumbent upon both Jew and Gentile Believer with no choice. Zech 14 says it all.
3. Let's not allow this Festival calendar to be dry and boring but ask the Ruach HaKodesh to refill you and to give you fresh perspective.
