#### Introduction

### The Love in Yehovah's Wisdom

#### Genesis 2:7-8

- 1. We see here in these verses that Yehovah created man out of the of the earth. Modern science verifies that the human body comprises elements such as carbon, hydrogen, oxygen, nitrogen, calcium, phosphorus, and numerous trace elements. Remarkably, these same fundamental elements are also abundant in the ground ("dust"). Laboratory analyses of soil samples across the globe, for instance in geological research performed at major universities, demonstrate that these elements are common in both organisms and Earth's crust.
- 2. In vs 8 It says Yehovah planted a garden then placed the man inside of it.
- Yehovah commissioned our ancestor Adam to be a gardener and a caretaker of Yehovah's original creation.

## Yehovah's Wisdom and Our Senses

#### Genesis 2:9

- 1. Yehovah sprouted from the ground every tree that was desirable for food that is good.
- He then created 2 other trees one is called the Tree of Life and the Other He called the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil.
- 3. The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil is a parallel to what we are to do which is to have discernment of to know what good and evil are!

#### Genesis 2:15-17
