1 John 1

Introduction

- 1. John the Apostle in these three epistles is called John the Elder
- 2. John has to be one of the most vocal of the Apostles regarding Torah Obedience
- 3. John was the second leading writer of the Brit Chadash. He wrote 5 books.

Yeshua is the Word of Life

1 John 1:1-2

Yochanan was explaining in a different way what He wrote in His Gospel. That which was
from the beginning, what we have seen with our eyes; and what we have looked at and
touched with our hands concerning the Word of Life.

- The Life was revealed and we have seen and testify and declare to you the eternal life that was with he Father and was revealed to us.
- 3. Yochanan and the other Apostles were testifying of what they saw.

The Proclamation of Yeshua

1 John 1:3-4

- 1. What we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you so you may have fellowship with us.
- 2. He wants to fellowship with us.
- Our Fellowship is with the Father and His Son, Yeshua the Messiah. He is writing to believers so that our joy might be complete.

Yehovah's Light Dispels the Darkness

1 John 1:5-6

- 1. Yochanan's message was that Elohim is light and in Him there is absolutely NO darkness.
- 2. In Him we have no darkness at all because He is the Light of the World. (Prov 2:12-13; Isa. 9:2; 50:10).
- 3. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and keep walking in the darkness we are lying

Walk in the Light

1 John 1:7-8

- 1. If we walk in the light as He Himself is in the we have fellowship with one another.
- 2. We also see that the blood of Yeshua His Son purifies us from all sin.
- 3. If we say we have no sin we are deceived and the truth is not in us.

Confession is Good For the Soul

1 John 1:9-10

- If we confess our sins He is Faithful and Just to forgive our sins and Purify us from all unrighteousness.
- 2. If we say we have not sinned we make Him a liar and His word is not in us.
- 3. Yehovah is not a liar and His Word cannot not lie. (Ps. 32:5; 103:3; Prov. 28:13; Jer. 31:31-32,34).

Take Away

1. Yeshua is the Light of the World and in Him there is no darkness.

- 2. If we say we have never sinned then we are liars and the Truth of Yehovah is not in us.
- 3. There is no sin that Yeshua cannot forgive and purify.

Application

- 1. I will continue to trust Yeshua the Light of the World so I will not be in darkness.
- 2. I will continue to walk in light the light as Yeshua is in light...that's Torah.
- 3. I will continue to live a righteous life by keeping clean and pure before Yeshua.
