### **My Way or Yah's Way**

### **Inheriting the blessings of Isaac**

#### **Introduction**

What do you think about when you read verses like verse 19 where it says these are the generations of Abraham's son. Then it goes into the family history Isaac and Esau. This is

where the seed is being passed down from one generation to the next. Two nations would be in Rivkah's womb one that is going to be the promised seed and the other one that would serve the promised seed. We now start to unfold the lives of Yaakov and Esav and are going to see where their journeys lead us too.

### **Genesis 26:4-6**

1. Yehovah would multiply the descendants of Yitzhak like the stars of the sky and he will give his seed all these lands. The land belongs to Yaakov's descendants period! Here is the Abraham covenant.
2. In His Yitzhak seed all nations will continually be blessed. This is another restating of the Abrahamic covenant but this time it says continually blessed.
3. because Abraham listened to Yehovah's voice, kept His charge and mitzvot including His decrees and instructions. Abraham obeyed Torah.

### **Genesis 26:12-13**

1. Isaac sowed in the land. He was obedient and He sowed in the land of promise. Psalm 37:3.
2. Isaac reaped a hundredfold. 2 Corinthians 9:6-9 a Brit Chadasha principle that comes from Torah.
3. Yehovah blessed him and He became great and continued to become greater until he

became very great.

#### **Genesis 26:17-22**

1. Isn't that just like the enemy? He desires to clog up the resources and stop the flow of what we need in our life.
2. He wants us to forsake and quit drawing from the outstanding truths that will enable us to walk in our full potential
3. The Word admonishes us that "...we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away" (Hebrews 2:1).

#### **Genesis 26:24-25**

1. Yehovah appeared to him that night and said I am Elohim of your father Abraham. Do not be afraid for I am with you. (Isaiah 35:4; Isaiah 41:10;41:13).
2. Yehovah bless you (Psalm 115:12;Psalm 128:4; Psalm 24:5).
3. Yehovah will multiply your seed for the sake of Abraham.

#### **Genesis 26:25**

1. Yitzhak built an altar there.
2. Yitzhak called on the Name of Yehovah.

3. Yitzhaks servants hollowed out a well there. (Isaiah 12:3).

## **Take Away**

1. Yitzhak was blessed like His Father Abraham
2. Yitzhak built wells that His Father Abraham built
3. Yitzhak built an altar and called on the name of Yehovah

1. I will continue to sow in the land for faithfulness
2. I will unclog the wells of our Father Abraham.
3. Call upon Yehovah and worship Him and not yourself.
