Seeds of Life Series: Torah the Seeds for Life

The Priesthood of the Seed

Introduction

We are still in the Tabernacle section of our Torah where we have all of the materials and things that we need for the offerings of the Tabernacle. Now we are establishing the priesthood and what that all means to us as Messianic believers. It means everything! I want us to focus on what we have been called to do and how we are not doing our calling as believers. We are called to be ambassadors of the Kingdom of Messiah like what it is said in 2 Corinthians 5:20.

We aren't being ambassadors of Messiah if all we do is think about our selves and our personal wants. When was the last time we shared with someone about the good news of Yeshua HaMashiach. If we can't think of a time then that means we don't talk about Him. After the consecration of the priesthood Yehovah gives instructions of how to pray such as setting up the Altar of Incense. This is our go to and our weapon of warfare. Today though we are going to talk about the inauguration of the priesthood but also about being a False Believer.

The Consecrated Seed

Exodus 29:1

1. This is what you are to do to consecrate or l'kadesh them!
2. Also this is what you are to do to allow them to minister as kohanim.
3. Take one young bull and two rams without blemish. (Lev. 8:2)

The Bread of the Seed

Exodus 29:2

1. First they were to take Matzot along with that...
2. They were to take cakes of Matzot mixed with oil along with that...
3. Matzot wafers spread with oil and make them out of fine wheat. (Fellowship offerings)

The Garments of the Seed

Exodus 29:4-6

1. Moses was to bring Aaron and His sons to the door of the Tent of Meeting meaning that all for of His sons went including Nadav and Avihu. (Hebrews 10:22).
2. Put the Tunic and the garments on Aaron including the robe, ephod, and the breastplate. (Breast Plate of Righteousness.
3. The Turban on his head and holy coronet or Holy Crown on his head. The Mark of Elohim on the Forehead. (Ezekiel 9:4; Revelation 9:4).

The Priestly Seed Gets Clothed Too

Exodus 29:8-9

1. Nadav, Avihu, Eliezar and Ithamar were all four brought before Yehovah and clothed with priestly garments. Lev. 8:18.
2. You are to clothe them with all the priestly garments as Aaron had on by a perpetual statute.
3. In this way you are consecrate Aaron and His sons. (Leviticus 8:13; Hebrews 7:28. Ezekiel 44:23).

The Priestly Seeds Atonement

Exodus 29:10-14

1. They are to bring the bull before the Tent of Meeting and Aaron and His sons are to lay their hands on its head. It was a transfer sin on an innocent animal.
2. Then use the blood to cover everything. This was a total sin offering.
3. Not all of those who were getting consecrated remained consecrated! They were false priests and were killed in Leviticus 10 for presenting unauthorized fire.

Take Away

1. The Priests were to be clothed with the Priestly Garments and present Fellowship Offerings to Yehovah.
2. The Priests were then covered by the blood as consecration unto Him.
3. Not all the Priests were completely consecrated to Elohim.

Application

1. I will continue to strive to be consecrated before Yehovah my Elohim.
2. I will continue to put on the whole armor of Elohim which are the priestly garments.
3. I will thank Yehovah that the Blood of Yeshua cleanses me totally and completely from my

sin.
