Rosh Chodesh Message

Let No Man Deceive You

1 John 3:1-10

Introduction

1. The Father bestowed love upon us that we should be called Sons of God.
2. Abiding is a big theme in this chapter
3. Yochanan is very clear on what sin is and who are sinners.

What Love That Was Given Us!

1 John 3:1

1. We do not really fully realize the love of Yehovah our Father.
2. He loves us so much that we are called Sons of God...B'nei Elohim.
3. The World does not know us because it did not know him!

We Will Be Like Him

1 John 3:2-3

1. Beloved was a favorite term of address for Yochanan (vs. 21: 4:1, 7,11).
2. It is a reminder that believers are what they are because Elohim has loved them (4:10).
3. The world may think little of Elohim's children now, but at Messiah's return things will change: believers will be transformed.

What Is Sin?

1 John 3:3-6

1. Knowing that the Master will return is a strong incentive for believers to live in ways that are pleasing to Him.
2. Sin is a grave matter because Elohim has revealed His moral character in His holy Torah and sin is breaking the Torah. It is a person offense against Elohim. Romans 4:15.

3. Yochanan was aware that believers sin. They can receive forgiveness through Yeshua's death as they confess their sins (1:9). In condemning whosoever sinners. Yochanan had in mind flagrant sins by false "believers" whose confession was feigned (2:23) whose love was set on the world rather than Elohim (2:15), and whose obedience was lacking. Yeshua Himself warned about people who called Him "Lord" and did great things in His name, but ultimately were not genuine disciples. (Matthew 7:21-23).

Do Not Be Deceived

1 John 3:7-8

1. HaSatan continually seeks to subvert and deceive Elohim's people. We must be vigilant always.
2. When believers forsake sin, they thwart the devils aims and further God's kingdom.
3. Matthew 13:38; John 8:44

Are We Born of God?

1 John 3:9-10

1. On do not commit sin lets go back to verse 6. Elohim's seed is the gospel message. Believers are born of Elohim by the work of his word, and this makes them able to do what is right. (vs.7)
2. Cannot sin means freedom from bondage to the law of sin and death and freedom to live

as Elohim's children.

3. Yochanan spoke of what spiritual rebirth makes manifest not...definitely not sinless perfection but a life surrendered fully to Elohim.

Take Away

1. We don't really fully realize Yehovah's Love for us.
2. Sin is the transgression of the Torah.
3. We have been called to live out the Torah and we have been freed from the law of sin and death.

Application

1. I will rejoice that Yeshua loves me completely.
2. I will continue to live righteously in a dark world.
3. The Torah helps us live righteously so I will continue to live out Torah.
