Seeds of Life Series: Torah the Seeds for Life

The Banqueting Seed

Introduction

In this portion we have start the ordinances of the covenants which are the everyday laws that Yehovah has for His people. Such as how to treat your servant all the way to what happens if you strike your mother or father. We also see laws about animals and how to treat them and also what would happen if animals attack members of the community. These are everyday mitzvot. The Torah is how we are to live our lives each and every day in the fact because that is

how Yehovah designed it. We are to live our His Word every single word of Elohim our awesome creator is forever.

The Invitation to Come Up

Exodus 24:1-3

1. Yehovah told Moses to come up to Him both Him and Aaron, Nadav and Avihu, and the seventy elders of Israel.
2. Moses was the only one that was allowed to approach Yehovah but the others may NOT draw near nor are the people to go up with him. Being Set apart is what matters.
3. Moses went to all the people and spoke all the ordinances of Yehovah and the people responded all that Yehovah has asked us to do we will do. The Torah was taught audibly! Acts 15:21 says that Torah is taught in the synagogues well after Yeshua rose from the dead.

Moses Wrote Down the Word

Exodus 24:4-6

1. Moses wrote down all the words of Yehovah. Where is the Talmud? Nowhere because Moses wrote it ALL down.
2. He then built an altar below the mountain and along with 12 pillars for the twelve tribes.

3. He sent out young men who sacrificed burnt offerings and fellowship offerings of oxen to Yehovah. Why? Because the priesthood hadn't been established then. Back then the father of the home was the priest and he made atonement for the sins of their houses.

Just look at Job.

The Blood Of the Covenant Matters

Exodus 24:8

1. This blood that was sprinkled on the people was a covenant that was cut in blood.
2. He poured it out on the altar then read from the Scroll of the Covenant.
3. Then Moses took the Blood and sprinkled it on the people. How did he sprinkle over a million people at once? Remember the 12 pillars in verse 4?

The Elders Banqueted with Elohim

Exodus 24:9-12

1. The Elders of Israel went up to meet Elohim!
2. He said come up to the mountain and stay there, and I will give you the tablets of stone with the Torah and the Mitzvot which I have written so that you may instruct them. The last two words are emphasized.
3. We are invited to join in covenant with Yeshua and to follow His commandments as a

follower of Yeshua.

Moses's 40 Day Torah Countdown

Exodus 24:13-18

1. Moses went up on the cloud covered mountain. A cloud covered it for 6 days then on the seventh day He called out to Him from the. This by the way does not necessarily mean this particular seventh day was a Sabbath day. Remember He was on the Mountain for 40 days. Hebrews 12:18,29.
2. The appearance of the glory of Yehovah was like a consuming fire. (ochelet) eating. The fire looked like it was eating the mountain.
3. Moses went up on the mountain for preparation for 40 days and 40 nights. Think about our 40 day prayer and preparation days we are trying to do.

Take Away

1. Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Avihu and the 70 elders went up to Sinai to have a meal with Yeshua.
2. Moses was instructed to sprinkle the blood on the people of Israel.
3. Moses was on the Mountain for 40 days and 40 nights receiving the Torah.

Application

1. Today I will be thankful for the covenant of the blood.
2. I will continue to seek Elohim's Glory in my life that He might use me greater.
3. I will thank Yehovah that His Torah was given and that we have an opportunity to live it out.
