My Way or Yah's Way

My Three Son

Introduction

As we look at this parashah this week which is named Noach shows us a reminder of what

Yeshua said in Matthew 24 that in the days of Noah so shall the coming of the Son of Man be. Then Yeshua goes into what will happen in the last days. Folks the same things that happened in the Days of Noah are happening today in this time that we are in. We also see the great flood which by the way is a prophetic sign of the coming judgment of the earth. In other words if Yehovah doesn't judge our generation for our wickedness then He will have to owe Noah's generation an apology. We are very close to that time of Yeshua's return and the coming judgement so we must be ready. However today I want to focus on three of Noah's sons and the prophecy of what was to come from them.

Genesis 9:18-19

1. Noah's sons who came out from the ark were Shem, Ham and Japheth and Ham was the father of Canaan.
2. All the nations came from these 3 sons. (See Genesis 10).
3. That also means all the knowledge of Yehovah came with them as well because Noah taught them about Yehovah.

Genesis 9:20-21

1. Noah was the first to plant a vineyard. It was a sin that he committed right after the flood. No one really knows why He did it but He did.
2. It says he drank some of the wine and got drunk on it. We don't have all the answers as to

why he got drunk.

3. It says He also uncovered himself meaning that His nakedness was exposed.

Genesis 9:22-23

1. Ham Canaan's father saw his father's nakedness and told his two brothers.
2. That is against Torah to uncover someone's nakedness. (Leviticus 18:7).
3. Shem and Japheth took a cloak and immediately covered their father without looking at his nakedness. They chose the Yah's way and respected their father and covered him up!

Genesis 9:24-25

1. Basically the Scripture says when Noah sobered up he found out what His son did and he was not happy.
2. This is why Scripture is always tellings us to be sober minded and be vigilant. Do not judge Noah for the same things we do. You don't have to be drunk in order to not be sober. Distraction can also cause you not to be alert.
3. Noah said Canaan is curses he is lowest slave to his brother. This is NOT the white supremacy tale that these confederates made up over 150 years ago to say this is where the black race came from. It's a spiritual curse.

Genesis 9:26

1. Blessed be Yehovah Elohim of Shem. This shows that Shem was a true follower of Yehovah and the Shemites were not present at the tower of Babel.
2. Canaan will be His servant. This was fulfilled in the Book of Joshua.
3. The Canaanites became servants and water carriers for the Altar of Yehovah. ex. Gibeonites.

Genesis 9:27

1. May Yehovah enlarge Japheth meaning that Japheth will have the most descendants.
2. Japheth dwelling in the tents of Shem is prophecy that the Gentiles will Dwell with the Israelites. Shem the Father of Israel Japheth the Father of the Nations.
3. Canaan will be his slave again a curse because from Canaan comes the Canaanite religions and the we have Nimrod etc.

Genesis 9:28-29

1. Noah lived 350 years after the flood. He lived to be an old man who served the Yehovah the rest of His days teaching men the ways of the true Elohim.
2. May we also live long lives and teach others the true ways of Yehovah and His Torah. That Yeshua is the only way to Elohim!
3. All of Noah's days were 950 years and then he died. We are all promised a death date. We don't know when this is but it is appointed unto man to die once and then the judgement. Are you ready for that day of judgement?

Take Away

1. Two of Noah's sons chose the Way of Yehovah and taught their descendants the truth.
2. Ham chose the way of darkness and mocked his father's nakedness and received a curse for his sins.
3. Japheth is symbolic of the Gentiles who will one day dwell with Israel as one people under one shepherd. Halleluyah!

Application

1. I will live my life soberly in this wicked world and be a watchman on the walls
2. I strive to continue to live for Yehovah and please Him rather than men around me.
3. I will ready myself to meet Yehovah when that time comes whether in death or in the final regathering!
