Seeds of Life Series: Torah the Seeds for Life

The Worshipping Seed

Introduction

We as the Seed of Yehovah have been commanded to worship Yehovah in bad times and good times. We worship Him because of who He is and who we aren't. Remember this it is NOT about ourselves it is about Yeshua and what He has done in our lives. We can praise him through all of our circumstances and through all of our problems in our lives. It's hard in our lives to praise Him but we must. We have no choice and this week we see that the Children of Israel

crossed the Red Sea and worshipped Him.

The Salvation of Israel

Exodus 14:29-31

1. The children of Israel had walked on dry land in the midst of the sea this shows that Yehovah will walk with us. (Isaiah 43:1-2).
2. Yehovah saved Israel that day out of the hands of the Egyptians. What is your story? How did He save you?
3. When the people saw the deliverance of Yehovah they feared Yehovah and worshipped Him. They worshipped.

The Children of Israel Sang

Exodus 15:1-2

1. The very first thing that Moshe and the Children of Israel did was they sang praises to Yehovah. (Heb. Shir To sing spontaneously).
2. The horse and rider He has thrown into the sea. (Revelation 15:3.)
3. Yehovah is my strength and salvation He has become my Yeshua (Revelation 12:10).

Israel's Enemies Sank in the Sea

Exodus 15:19

1. Pharaoh and His army died at the bottom of the sea by allowing the water to be their judgement.
2. Yehovah allowed the children of Israel to walk in the midst of the season dry ground.
3. Yehovah can and has used water to bring judgement upon the earth.

Miriam and the Women of Israel Danced

Exodus 15:20-21

1. Miriam the Prophetess Aaron's sister took a tambourine in her hand and led dancing.
2. The women danced before Yehovah. Dancing is a commandment before Yehovah.
(Psalm 149:3; Psalm 30:11; Psalm 150:4).
3. They danced after the warfare. They sang during the battle and they danced after the battle. Is there a format? Are there certain protocols of worship?

The Sweet Water Ordinance

Exodus 15:22-26

1. As the Children of Israel left they across bitter water and Yehovah commanded Moses to throw in a tree branch and the water became sweet. "Vayorehu Yehovah etz" As Yehovah

taught Moses the Torah. The branch made the water come alive. Like a tree of life. Etz Chayim!

2. He made a statute and an ordinance for them and there He tested them.
3. If you diligently listen to the voice of Yehovah your Elohim do what is right in His eyes pay attention to his mitzvoth and keep all His decrees I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians. For I am Yehovah who heals you.

Take Away

1. We are to sing to Yehovah spontaneously as we go through adversity
2. Dance before Yehovah with all of your might even if you look undignified.
3. Yehovah gave us a statute to turn our bitterness to life!

Application

1. I will sing before Yehovah even when I don't feel like it.
2. Dance before Him even if you look ridiculous.
3. If I want to turn my bitterness to sweetness then I will follow Yehovah's commandments.
