Seeds of Life Series: Torah the Seeds for

Life

Are you Part of the Remnant Seed?

Introduction

In this portion we are going to see the remnant very strongly portrayed here. The question that

is being posed here this morning is are you part of the remnant? How do you know you are part

of the remnant? Are you enduring to the end to be saved? Not everyone that says they are part

of the remnant are part of the remnant. Not every Jew is part of Israel if you also want to look at

it this way. Are you moving forward or are you looking backwards? What happens when you look backwards? These are just questions that we should be thinking about this week.

Abraham intercedes for the Seed

Genesis 18:16-21

- 1. Abraham pleads for the city of Sodom because He cares for it. (1 Timothy 2:1-4).
- 2. Our job is the intercede for our cities and to seek the peace where we live (Jeremiah 29:7).
- 3. Yeshua is our final intercessor! (Hebrews 7:9).

Abraham preserves His seed

Genesis 18:20-21

- Yehovah reveals what He is doing to Sodom and Gomorrah to Abraham because He is living righteously
- Abraham commanded his descendants and his household to keep the way of Yehovah by doing righteousness and justice.
- According to Yeshua these are parts of the weightier matters of the Torah (Matthew 23:23).

Lot tries to prepare His Seed

Genesis 19:14

- 1. Lot first warns His sons in law about the coming destruction.
- 2. Lots sons in law do not listen to the warning about destruction.
- 3. They thought the coming destruction was a joke. (2 Peter 3:3-4).

The Angels Snatched Lot and His Family Out

Genesis 19:15-17

- 1. The Angels grabbed Lot and His family and dragged them out of the city. (Jude 23).
- 2. Notice that Lots daughters were virgin daughters Look at Matthew 25
- 3. Is this pointing to the preparation of the virgins perhaps in a layer of prophecy?

Not Everyone that is the Remnant are the Remnant

Geneis 19:23-26

- 1. The Angels said head for the hills but don't look back.
- 2. He who endures to the end will be saved (Matthew 24:13).
- 3. Don't look back! (Isaiah 43:18;Luke 9:62).

Take Away

- 1. Make sure you heed the Angels Warning.
- 2. Lot's Family thought He was crazy and so will yours
- 3. He who endures to the end will be saved.

Application

- 1. I will continue to examine myself to see if I am in the Faith
- 2. I will heed the Scriptures instructions to flee from the Wrath to Come. (Matthew 3:7).
- 3. I will not turn back because I do not want to become something that belongs on a dining room table or worse!
