# Yeshua Atoned For Our Sins

## 1 John 2 :1-11

### Introduction

1. Yeshua's Blood is stronger than all!
2. Loving Elohim Means Obedience
3. People who stumble in darkness perishes.

### Yeshua's Atonement

#### 1 John 2:1-2

1. look at sin as breaking Torah. John was writing this letter so that we do not break Torah  
but if there is one that breaks Torah.
2. John said that if we do break Torah we have the Living Torah that intercedes for us as

Torah Breakers.

3. Yeshua is the atonement for our sins and not only of our sins but also of the whole world.

(Lev. 16:30; 17:11; Isa. 53:11-12).

## Loving Elohim is Obedience

### 1 John 2:3-5

1. John says here that the we come to know Yehovah is by keeping His commandments.

Here is the proof you need.

2. Don't say you know Him and break His commandments because you are a false believer.
3. Keeping the Word of Elohim is what makes the Love of Elohim perfect in someone.

## Walk Like Yeshua

### 1 John 2:6

1. Whoever claims to abide in Yeshua must walk just as He walked.
2. Abide in the Greek is *menó* which means to permanently dwell with.
3. Walk in the Greek is *peripateó* Hebraistically, to live (cf. Winers Grammar, 32; common in Paul and John, but not found in James or in Peter (cf. ἀναστρέφω 3 b., ἀναστροφή)), i. e. α. to regulate one's life, to conduct oneself the same meaning as Halakha!

# The Commandment from the Beginning

## 1 John 2:7-8

1. John here is telling His flock that He is not giving them a new commandment but an old commandment they have had from the beginning. The Torah is the commandment we have had since the beginning.
2. There is nothing new about the Torah it has been around for 2,000 years and its unchanged. Yah's Word never changes.
3. John in verse 8 says he gives a new commandment but its the word kainos which means an Unworn out commandment.

# The Light and Darkness

## 1 John 2:9-11

1. Someone who says that he hates his brother is not in the light but in darkness its the same word Yeshua uses in Luke 14:26 *miséō Love less does not necessarily mean hate but can also mean persecute.*
2. If you love your brother then you are in the light and you have no cause to stumble. The Light shows the way. agapaó
3. If someone hates his brother then he can't see in the dark so he stumbles on the path. (Leviticus 19:17).

## **Take Away**

1. We are to walk the way Yeshua walks if we want to abide in Him.
2. If we say we have Torah but don't walk it we are liars.
3. Yeshua is the light that lights our Darkness

## **Application**

1. I will walk as Yeshua walks
2. I will strive to be obedient to Yehovah to show Him that I love them.
3. Today I will love my brother and not hate Him.
