My Way or Yah's Way

The Renewal of the Covenant

Introduction

We finally come to the Torah portion that can be one of the most controversial portions of all of the Torah because of its subject matters that are discussed here. Here are just a few of them that will be taught on in another portion down the road. The ransom, the wash basin, the prohibition of the replication of the Anointing Oil of the Tabernacle. Yehovah again reiterates that

He gave Shabbat as a perpetual covenant sign and then they immediately go into the idolatry of the golden calf worship. Therefore Moshe in his anger threw the tablets the covenant at the calf and broke the tablets and thus bringing judgement upon the children of Israel. Now we come to Moshe being told to get another set of commandments.

Exodus 34:1-2

1. Yehovah commanded Moshe to carve yourself a second set of tablets for the renewal of the covenant again. Israel sinned, Moshe interceded for the people and Yehovah forgave.
2. Lesson: After we make vows to Elohim or promises to Elohim be careful because the test will come. (1 Peter 1:7; Ps 66:10; Prov 17:3).
3. Yehovah commanded Moshe to be ready to meet with him. (Hosea 10:12; Matt 24:42-43; Rom 13:11; 1 Thess. 5:6).

Exodus 34:3-4

1. This time no one is to come up with you not even Joshua. Moshe went up alone to speak to Yehovah.
2. Yeshua went up to the mountains to pray to His Father alone. Matthew 6:6 is very important. You must have personal time with Yehovah. You will spiritually die if you don't.
3. Moses then carved the two tablets of stone and went up to the mountain early in the morning and heard received the Second set of commandments. It was the renewal of the

covenant.

Exodus 34:5

1. Yehovah descended in the cloud. Yeshua descends in 1 Thess. 4:16, Zech 12:10, Revelation 19:11. Are you ready for Yeshua when He descends? The disciples didn't know what would happen after He ascends.
2. Yehovah stood with Him there. Yehovah stands with many people in the Bible. He stands with Abraham, the 3 sons of Israel in the fiery furnace, He walks with Adam in the cool of the Garden. Yehovah stands with you there.
3. Moses calls on the Name of Yehovah. Moses V'yikrah meaning He proclaimed the name of Yehovah! What happens after that?

Exodus 34:6-7

1. Then Yehovah passed before him and passed over the word avar and this time Yehovah Va'yikrah. If you proclaim Him He will proclaim you. (Luke 9:26).
2. Yehovah then reveals himself a compassionate and gracious. (rachum v'chanun) Slow to anger (erech appayim) erech means have a long appayim meaning face or nose. He was long nosed or faced in the fact that He is long patient. (2 Peter 3:9), abundant in lovingkindness and truth. Having great chesed and v'emet. But Emet has a very interesting definition it means faithfulness or stability.

3. He shows mercy to a thousand generations and forgiving iniquity and transgression.

Transgression is the word in Hebrew v'fasha coming from a root word meaning Pesha.

Willful rebellion against God's commandments. The term implies a conscious decision to break away from a covenant or established order, highlighting the gravity of the offense.

It's literally crossing a physical, spiritual or even a gender boundary.

Exodus 34:8-10

1. Moshe quickly bowed his head down to the earth and worshipped. The Hebrew here meant that He speedily or urgently worshipped Yehovah.
2. Moshe then goes into intercede for the children of Israel and asked Yehovah to go with them on their journey and to pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for your own inheritance. One day this will happen to all of Israel. Once the fullness of the Gentiles comes in then all Israel will be saved. Romans 11.
3. Yehovah then said I am cutting a covenant. Before all people I will do wonders such as have not been done in all the earth, or in any nation. All people you are among will see the word of Yehovah for what I am going to do with you will be awesome. What can Yehovah do with us if we are totally yielded to him? Could He use us for His glory? Could He do something wonderful through us so that all the people we are among will see His wonders? We stop short of that. Our own sinfulness keeps us from seeing that. Our own Apathy keeps us from that.

Take Away

1. Moses had to make a second set of tablets and go up to the mountain alone to receive Yehovah's commandments again.
2. Yehovah descended onto the mountain and proclaimed Himself to Moses.
3. He proclaimed a mighty promise to Him about the exclusive Covenant. The Covenant is Exclusive.

Application

1. Will you proclaim the Name of Yehovah in your life today?
2. Will you urgently worship Yehovah and seek His face and his presence? His presence is a privilege not a right.
3. We are walking out an all exclusive covenant with the God of Israel, the Ancient of Days, and the One who will be here in bodily form and His name is Yehoshua HaMashiach.
