Lessons from Peter

Qualities for Living Forever

2 Peter 1:1-14

- **Vs.1-2** Simon Peter a slave and emissary of Messiah Yeshua to those which are us who have received a faith equal to ours through the righteousness of our Elohim and Saviour, Messiah Yeshua. Not only are we equal in faith to the Apostles we are blessed with multiplied to you in the knowledge of Elohim and of Yeshua our Lord.
- **Vs.3**-Yehovah's divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness, through knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and virtue.
- **Vs.4**-Yehovah has given us these wonderful things He has given us His precious and

magnificent promises, so that thought them you may become partakers of the divine nature since you have escaped the corruption that evil desires have brought into the world.

- **Vs.5**-Now for this very reason, making every effort, adopt your faith virtue; and to virtue, knowledge.
- **Vs.6**-from knowledge to self control, patience, and to patience, godliness.
- **Vs.7**-From godliness, brotherly love; and to brotherly love, love.(Galatians 6:10; 1 Thessalonians 3:12; 5:15; 1 John 4:21).
- **Vs. 8**-If we have these qualities in our life and they increase they keep you from becoming idle and unfruitful in the knowledge our Lord Yeshua the Messiah. (John 15:2; Titus 3:14).
- **Vs.9**-However, if anyone who lacks these qualities is blind or nearsighted as the Scripture calls it because he has forgotten his cleansing from past sins. (1 John 2:9,11; Eph. 5:26; Hebrews 9:14; 1 John 1:7).

- **Vs. 10**-Therefore, brother and sisters make all the more effort to make your calling and election certain for if you keep doing these things you will never stumble. (1 John 3:19).
- **Vs.11**-For in this way entry into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior, Messiah Yeshua, will be richly provided.
- **Vs.12**-Kefa here continues to remind us of these things, even though you know them and are well grounded in the truth that you have. Being reminded over and over is a very apostolic and a very Torah things. (Romans 15:14-15; Phil 3:1; 1 John 2:21; Jude 5).
- **Vs.13**-I think it right to stir you up with a reminder as long as I remain alive in this tent of a body (2 Cor 5:1,4). As long as Kefa was living He was going to continue to remind people of Yehovah's ways and words.
- **Vs. 14**-Kefa knew that His death as soon as Yeshua the Master made it clear to Him. (Deut 4:21-22; 31:14; 2 Tim 4:6; John 21:18-19).

- **Vs. 15**-He would make every effort to always remember these things even after His departure.
