ROSH CHODESH MEANS HEAD OF THE MONTH

Rosh Chodesh can last anywhere between 1-2 days, as evidenced in 1 Sam. 20:5-6, 18, 24-35.

We encourage you all to keep the First Night of Rosh Chodesh with your Families, unless otherwise listed.

Feasts dates should never be a point of contention or division. The point is to "Keep the Feasts", for obedience is better than sacrifice (**1 Samuel 15:22**). So whether you keep the Feasts according to the Aviv, Conjunction or the Rabbinical Calendar, go out and keep the Commandment of keeping the Feasts. ROSH CHODESH lasts 1-2 Days (**1 Sam. 20:5-6, 18, 24-35**), the dark moon can vary between 1-3.5 days. Therefore we believe The Father does give us grace and leeway if we're truly trying our best to honor His Moedim. Our **ROSH CHODESH** Dates are calculated using our **Local Area Times of Lunation (Auburn/Opelika, Alabama area)**. **ROSH CHODESH** service days are **HIGHLIGHTED** in **BLACK**, while dates **HIGHLIGHTED** in **RED** highlight the **1<sup>st</sup>** and **7<sup>th</sup>** month of the Biblical Year. Check your local area times for exact lunation and sundown times or check Jerusalem Times if you prefer. Dates listed are from **sundown to sundown (S-S/S2S)**.
