# **Pesach**

## **The Covenant Renewed**

### **Introduction**

We finally come to Pesach where we are celebrating the Lamb and what He has done for us and the meaning behind all of it. We have had our seder and fulfilled the commandment for the year and we also stayed up and made a watch for ourselves. Some of us had to fight sleep and fatigue but that is also part of the whole part of making it a watch. Do we watch? Do we gather? Do we pray and fight? Do we celebrate?

## **Elohim renews the Covenant**

**Exodus 34:10**

1. Elohim makes a covenant with Israel in the midst of all of the Gentiles.

2. This covenant will be established through miracles that have not been performed in any of the Gentiles nations before.
3. The Gentiles will see the work of Yehovah for it is a fearful thing that He is going to perform with them.

## Remember to Comply

### Exodus 34:11

1. Be careful to Shomer His commandments; in the midst of our obedience He will do battle for us.
2. He will drive out our enemies before us.
3. Our enemy will flee from before us.

## What to do with the enemy

### Exodus 34:12-14

1. Be careful who you covenant with. Are they inhabitants of the land? They will snare you.
2. You are to tear down altars and smash their sun pillars and Asherah/Ishtar/Easter emblems
3. You shall not worship any other god because Yehovah whose name is jealous (Hb Kanna) His jealousy is rooted in complete love for us and wants all of us. The Fenton Bible for

you shall not worship another GOD, for the EVER-LIVING is **jealous of HIS NAME**; He is a jealous GOD."

## What You Might Do

### Exodus 34:15-17

1. You might make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land and they would prostitute themselves with their gods; sacrifice to their gods and some one might invite you to eat of his sacrifice. It's okay to have a Christmas dinner or Easter dinner with people!
2. You might take some of his daughters for his sons and his daughters might prostitute themselves with their gods and cause your sons also to prostitute themselves with their gods. (Deut 32:37,38).
3. You shall not make any gods cast in metal. (Exod. 20:4; 23; Lev 19:4 Deut 5:8).

## The Feast of Unleavened Bread

### Exodus 34:18

1. You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread.
2. You are to eat Unleavened Bread for Seven Days as He commanded us to eat it.
3. You are to eat it at its appointed time. Not when you want to. Not early and Not late meaning everything has an appointed time.

## **Take Away**

1. Elohim Makes a Covenant with Israel in the midst of the Gentiles
2. Our God is a Jealous God and His name is Jealous
3. Everything has an appointed time.

## **Application**

1. I will continue to observe all that Yehovah has commanded us!
2. As God is jealous for us we should be jealous for him.
3. I will ask the Father to allow us to do things in their appointed times.
