Rosh Chodesh Message

Major Events of the Biblical New Year

Introduction

Have you ever wondered what other events have Happened on this day of the Biblical New Year since Yehovah told Moshe that this day is to be the New Year that sets His calendar in motion!

The reason we do not celebrate the New Year in the Fall is because it's the Babylonian New year which is not Scriptural at all. In fact that day was already given a name by Yehovah. It is called Yom Teruah! Today I think you will be surprised at just how many events happened on this particular day that we call Biblical Rosh HaShana!

The Tabernacle was completed on this Day

Exodus 40:2,17

1. Yehovah told Moshe that on the first day of the first month you are to set up the Tabernacle.
2. On this day you are to put the Ark in the Tabernacle and screen it off afterwards you are to put the rest of the furniture in it. Basically set up House for Yehovah!
3. vs. 17 It says that in the second year on the in the first month of the second year the tabernacle was erected and then it ends with the Glory or Kavod settling down on the Mishkan!

Ezra Begins His Journey

Ezra 7:9-10

1. Ezra began his journey from Babylon to Jerusalem on the First Day of the First Month!
2. He started his journey because the good hand of His Elohim was upon him!
3. Ezra had firmly resolved to study the Torah of Yehovah and to practice it, and to teach His statutes and ordinances in Israel. In order for me to teach the Torah I myself have to practice it!

The Consecration of the Second Temple

2 Chronicles 29:17

1. They began the consecration of the Second Temple on the first day of the first month and on the eighth day of the month they entered the porch of Yehovah.
2. vs. 16 says that the priests went into the inner portion of the Temple and cleaned it out and brought every unclean thing first to the courtyard then the Levites carried them to the Kidron Valley to be burned!
3. They then consecrated the House of Yehovah in eight days and finished not the sixteenth day of the first month. The sixteenth day of Aviv is the day that Yeshua rose from the Dead!

The Third Temple will be completed

Ezekiel 45:18

1. The Priests are to take a bull without blemish and cleanse the sanctuary from sin.
2. Then is to take blood from the sin offering and put it on the door posts of the house on the four corners of the ledge of the altar and on the posts of the gate of the inner courtyard.
3. On the seventh day of the month you shall make atonement for everyone who does wrong inadvertently or who is naive. All this takes place before Aviv 14th.

Lessons for us during New Year

2 Samuel 11:1; Romans 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 5:7-8

1. Expect Spiritual Warfare during this time because this is when the kings or Melech go out to make war. Melech can mean Angels both Set apart or Fallen.
2. Watch your relationships during this time and make sure you are right with one another or you are distancing from people who are not living godly lives.
3. Prepare yourself to be a sanctuary for Yehovah during this time and ask the Ruach to reveal any leavening in your life that you need to get ride of. (1 Corinthians 5:7-8).

Take Away

1. The Biblical New Year is more than just a day but it was a day in which significant things took place in the Scriptures.
2. Strive to make the Biblical New Year the time that you will have a renewal in your life and not just let it pass you by.
3. Make sure you spend the next 13 days or so to search you heart and your homes.

Application

1. I will purpose in my heart to be like Ezra and practice and live out Torah.

2. I will be thankful that the events that happen in the Bible are for my instructions.
3. I will renew myself as a sanctuary to Yehovah and allow Him to work through my life.
