Lessons from Peter: It's a True Story!

2 Peter 1:15-21

Vs.15

 As one of the early leaders of the early Messianic community Kefa has also given us something to think about after His death.

 He will make every effort to have us remember this. Is there something you are trying to do with all of your effort? Fasting and Praying? Witnessing? Giving of your finances?
 Teaching?

 Kefa used the preparation of His departure by preparing the remnant for His coming and by teaching the Torah.

Vs.16

Kefa starts out by saying we didn't follow cleverly concocted tales. This was a direct
attack against the Jewish Theosophists and Gnostics who gave wild stories about Yeshua
and all things spiritual.

- They made the message known through the Power of the Lord Yeshua the Messiah. (Acts 4:33).
- They made known the message of the coming of the Lord Yeshua the Messiah, but they were eyewitnesses of His majesty. (1 Thessalonians 4; 2 Thessalonians 2 Titus 2:13).

Vs. 17

- When he received honor and glory from God the Father THEN a voice came from the Majestic Glory! What did He proclaim?
- This is my Son!
- Whom I love and am well pleased (John 3:16).

Vs. 18

- Kefa was saying here that He and the other two disciples that were on the Mount of
 Transfiguration heard the voice. This is an eyewitness account of things that happened.
- Yeshua according to Matthew 17:9 commanded the disciples not to mention this event until after Yeshua was ascended into Heaven.
- The voice was the voice of the Father communicating with His Son.

Vs. 19

- We have a reliable prophetic word. This means that we can rely on God's Word to be true and not be a lie.
- You will do well by paying attention to it.
- Until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts (Numbers 24:17). This is

Yeshua! (Revelation 22:16).

Vs.20

- Above all understand in this book of Peter understand this!
- No prophecy of Scripture comes about from a person's own interpretation. (2 Timothy 3:16).
- Beware of False Prophets who interpret prophecy based on their own interpretation.
 (Matthew 7:15-16).

Vs.21

- No prophecy was ever brought forth by human will.
- People spoke from Elohim as they were moved by the Ruach HaKodesh. (2 Samuel 23:2;
 2 Tim. 3:16).
- The Ruach HaKodesh is the Spirit of Truth that reveals all truth to believers. (John 16:13;
 1 John 4:6
