Introduction

Is there a question that you have ever wanted to ask Yehovah but have never gotten around to it? How about for Sukkot? Are there questions who have about Sukkot you would like answered? David had questions that He wanted to ask of the Lord?

The One Thing that I Ask

Psalm 27:4

- David asked one question of Yehovah and it was an important question.
- He also sought this question out with all of His heart and Soul. Have you gone that far?
- His request was to dwell in the House of Yehovah forever, to behold the beauty of Yehovah, and to meditate in His Temple.

In the Day of Trouble

Psalm 27:5

- David said that in the day of trouble Yehovah will hide you in His Sukkah. Yom Teruah we spoke about Yehovah's Shofar and now we are speaking about Yehovah's Sukkah.
- He asked if he could be concealed in his tent (Ohel).
- He asked to be set high upon a rock.

High Above my Enemies

- Yehovah will place us high above our enemies
- In His Sukkah we will offer sacrifices with shouts of joy
- We will sing praises to Yehovah. Sukkot is about singing and rejoicing. HaSatan is going to try to steal your joy.

Take Aways

- Are you asking the important questions?
- Yehovah will hide you in the day of trouble.
- Yehovah has his own Tabernacle as well.

Application

- I will ask the Yehovah and allow me to dwell in His Temple
- I will seek Him with all of my heart and soul
- I will sing for joy until I run out of breath in my body
