Day of Trumpets or Soundings

Don't Let the Door Shut

Introduction

Have you ever thought of a Jewish wedding? I've officiated several Jewish weddings over the years and I can say they are very joyful occasions. However they are also deeply rooted in prophetic Scripture. This year the enemy has not wanted me to teach this message for some reason. He attacked my computer and slowed it down then at one point I lost my previous notes because it didn't save after it was saved this is when I know that I am on target as to what to

speaking about. The Galilee wedding is much more intricate and in more detailed prophetic terms. We are going to break down some of that detail tonight. Yeshua comes the Kingdom of Elohim to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the groom.

Ten Virgins and Ten Lamps

Matthew 25:1-3

1. The Kingdom of Elohim is compared to ten virgins and ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the groom. (Matt 13:24; John 18:3; Acts 20:8; Rev 4:5; 8:10).
2. Five virgins in foolish and five were prudent.
3. The foolish virgins took their lamps but didn't take extra oil with them. However the Prudent or practical virgins took extra oil.

The Midnight Shout

Matthew 25:5-7

1. Now while the groom was delaying they all became drowsy and began to sleep. (Notice even the prudent virgins got tired and slept).
2. At midnight though there finally was a Teruah! A Shout and then the shofar was blasted. The shout was traditionally yelled out and is still today...Behold the Bridegroom Cometh!
3. Then the wise virgins stood up and started to trim their wicks because they had enough

oil.

Don't Run Out of Oil!

Matthew 25:8-10

1. The foolish stupid virgins asked the wise prudent virgins for some of their oil because they didn't make preparations.
2. However the prudent wise ones said to the foolish ones No! there most certainly would not be enough for us and you too; go instead to the merchants and buy some yourself. Uh Oh!
3. But while they were on their way to buy the oil the groom came and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast and the door was shut! (Matthew 24:42; Genesis 7:16). Once the doors are shut there is not NO MORE entry! You miss the wedding feast! You were ill prepared. You dillydallied too long.

It Won't Help to Beg

Matthew 25:11-12

1. Later the other virgins came and asked the Lord to let them in!
2. Many will come to Yeshua and ask Him to let them in to His Kingdom.

3. The answer He gives them is the same one He gives them in ch. 7 of Matthew 7:21).

Be Alert!

Matthew 25:13

1. What is the purpose of Yom Teru'ah? To prepare the believer for Yeshua's return.
2. It is a commandment to watch for His coming. (Matthew 24:42; Titus 2:13; 1 Thessalonians 5:6).
3. We are to serve Yeshua in the Present so we won't be ashamed of Yeshua in the future.

Take Away

1. There were wise and there were foolish virgins. Which category are you in?
2. They all heard the shout and the shofar.
3. Not everyone made it to the wedding feast.

Application

1. I will strive to be a wise virgin living and watch for Yeshua everyday.
2. I will stay alert and vigilant by the help of the Holy Spirit.
3. I will listen for the sound of the Shofar and the Shout.
