

# How Do I Obtain My Driver's License in Virginia If I Am 18 Or Under?

## DMV Regulations:

## Ashburn Driving School Offers This

Upon student's completion of four pre-requisites:

- (1) Learner's permit (2) Classroom course  
(3) Safe-teen course (4) 45-hour driving log

--Student must receive seven lessons from a DMV-certified instructor; each lesson must consist of 50 minutes of behind-the-wheel driving plus 50 minutes observing another student	Yes
--Instructor must use a DMV-inspected vehicle with auxiliary brake, mirrors, signage	Yes
--Student must drive a minimum of 50 miles per course	Yes
--Student must receive a 50-point DMV road test during the seventh lesson	Yes
--Student must receive a 180-day temporary license upon successful road test	Yes
--Instructor must complete and submit to DMV all required documents	Yes
--Instructor must hold student's paperwork in archives for three years	Yes
--Student must attend a licensing ceremony to obtain permanent license	----

### Additional Components:

--Student drives a minimum of 100 miles per course	Yes
--No more than two students drive with the instructor at any one time	Yes
--The same two students are paired together for the entire course	Yes
--The lesson schedule is tailored to both students' availability	Yes
--Pickup and dropoff are at the student's home or an Ashburn location	Yes
--Thorough, conscientious, clear, professional instruction is focused entirely on the students; instructor is not distracted by using a cell phone or doing paperwork during instruction time	Yes
--A fully DMV-regulated, family-sized vehicle is used, one that is large enough for student to gain practical experience for future vehicle use	Yes
--Instruction covers residential and highway driving and parking, including off-road recovery, steering sequences, emergency maneuvers, parallel parking	Yes
--An initial in-home meeting is provided for the student and at least one parent to review the student's availability and sign the DMV-required contract	Yes
--A final in-home meeting is provided for the student and at least one parent to receive a review of the course and sign the DMV licensing paperwork	Yes
--We remain available from initial phone call through ongoing follow-up	Yes
