

District 20 Delegate to Central California Fellowship of Alcoholics Anonymous

Central California Fellowship of Alcoholics Anonymous (CCFAA) is an Intergroup serving the greater Sacramento area since 1954.

- Non-voting member of District
- Suggested 2 years of sobriety
- Appointed by elected District officers
- Two-year commitment beginning even-numbered years

Requirements: Service experience at group or district levels. Comfort with entering information over the internet. A working knowledge of AA Traditions is essential.

Responsibilities: The delegate to CCFAA is responsible for communicating with the groups in District 20 and CCFAA.

Duties:

- The delegate sends information about district 20 meetings in order to keep them current on the CCFAA website, CCFAA printed schedule and AA meeting guide app.
- Familiarization with the CCFAA website <https://aasacramento.org/> and Meeting Guide App.
- Cooperates with GSRs, the meeting schedule person, registrar and webmaster to be sure meeting info is current prior to submitting it to CCFAA.
- Assists in getting new meeting info on the CCFAA website.
- Attends District 20 monthly meetings.
- May need to attend one meeting a year, either virtually or in person, depending on the CCFAA format.
- May request financial support if funding is needed (such as transportation costs).
- If unable to attend the District meeting, an alternate needs to be arranged and that alternate should have any needed reports and/or material for the meeting. If required to give a report and no one can attend, a written report may be sent. Failure to arrange this will be considered an absence. Three absences without contact in the calendar year will be considered as a resignation.
- Provides training to replacement upon rotation.
