What is PI - Public Information?

Public Information (P.I.) in Alcoholics Anonymous means carrying the message of recovery to the still-suffering alcoholic by informing the general public about the A.A. program.

What is CPC – Cooperation with the Professional Community?

Cooperation with nonalcoholic professionals is an effective way to carry the message to the sick alcoholic. Examples of Professionals: doctors, nurses, court official, educator, employee assistance professionals, therapists, clergy, senior services, social workers, school counselors, etc.
