HATS OFF FOR VETERANS, A TEXAS NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION, IS SEEKING VOLUNTEER REGIONAL DIRECTORS TO SUPPORT VETERANS ACROSS TEXAS

Kyle, Texas — Hats Off For Veterans (HOFV), a Texas-based nonprofit committed to improving the quality of life for those who bravely served our country, is currently seeking dedicated and passionate Volunteer Regional Directors. This fully remote, part-time volunteer position is ideal for someone who enjoys community involvement and is driven to make a meaningful impact in the lives of Texas veterans. HOFV's mission is to provide financial assistance to Texas veterans pursuing their first higher education degree and support professional development for those seeking certification or licensure in skilled trades.

In addition to its educational and professional development programs, HOFV also serves as a vital mental health resource for veterans across Texas. By connecting veterans with counseling services, peer support programs, and wellness initiatives, HOFV is dedicated to addressing the invisible wounds of military service. The organization strives to reduce the stigma around mental health and help veterans access the care and community they need to thrive beyond their service.

The Volunteer Regional Director will represent HOFV across multiple counties within their assigned region, participating in local community events, fundraisers, career fairs, and resource fairs. This role is crucial in promoting the organization's mission and services, building strong local relationships, and raising awareness about the needs of veterans in Texas. While prior military service is not required, veterans are strongly encouraged to apply.

Candidates must be reliable, self-motivated, and possess excellent communication and presentation skills. They must also be comfortable traveling to surrounding counties within their designated region and have access to reliable personal transportation. Travel expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with the General Services Administration (GSA) per diem rates for



state travel in Texas. In addition to their volunteer responsibilities, the Regional Director must commit to participating in a mandatory one-day strategic planning retreat held each August in Kyle, located in Hays County (Region 5).

As an incentive, the Volunteer Regional Director will receive 15% of the net profits from any fundraisers they coordinate that directly benefit HOFV. This opportunity is perfect for someone who values service, leadership, and community engagement, and wants to play a key role in supporting the educational, mental health, and professional advancement of Texas veterans.
