This summer we have had a lot of maintenance emergencies that kept us pretty busy. In between scheduling camps and making repairs, we were able to start several new projects. The Snack Shop was stained and sealed, it's now a nice chestnut brown and looks great!

With help from a volunteer youth group from downstate, we built a new stage for the amphitheater and are in the process of building a large trapeze swing for the lake. The camp has been working to repair the lake's dam so we can fill it again. We do have a couple more repairs to make to complete that project.

The lodge's upstairs dorms rooms are being remodeled and will sleep approximately 20 people. They will be available to rent this winter. The goal was to offer a place for families or church groups to come and stay and enjoy our beautifully groomed cross-country ski trails.



Several churches rented Northwoods this past summer and ran some great kids' camps. Northwoods also ran a week-long day camp. We were able to fully scholarship 15 of the 18 kids that came. The funding was available because of those who have generously donated towards our scholarship fund, and of those that came 10 children accepted Jesus as their Savior!



As summer and fall seasons come to a close, we are gearing up for the winter activities. Northwoods will be having their annual sleigh rides in December.
