Ichthus Music Festival returns to Servant Heart Farm Sept. 10

CAMPBELLSVILLE, Ky. – Ichthus Music Festival, which has celebrated Jesus Christ since 1970, is returning to ***Servant Heart Farm in Wilmore, Ky. Saturday, Sept. 10.***

The festival, which will feature a full lineup of contemporary Christian artists and bands, will open its gates at 11 a.m., music will begin at noon with the final concert to end at approximately 10:30 p.m.

Servant Heart Farm is located at 9533 Harrodsburg Road, Wilmore, Ky.

"As owner of Servant Heart farm and director of the new Ichthus, we are celebrating Christ through music and taking the Christian music festival back to the cross of Jesus."
