The Felton Institute is also running the IHART Mobile Crisis Service in Vallejo. IHART responds to and delivers effective services addressing mental health, substance abuse, and homelessness concerns within our community.

Program Components of IHART include:


- -Operating a mobile community resource team available 12 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- -Providing system navigation.
- -Facilitating peer and family support groups.
- -Training, informing, and assisting clients and their family members in developing the skills needed to care for and advocate effectively on behalf of those seeking services.

HOW'S YOUR BIBLE KNOWLEDGE? - Dave Mezzera

No quiz this time; just some Bible facts and trivia:

- † The first book ever printed on the Gutenberg "type mold" printing press was the Bible in 1454 CE. Gutenberg printed it in Latin and printed over 150 copies during the 1450s.
- † The first hand-written translation of the Bible into English was by John Wycliffe in 1382.
- † The Bible is still the best selling book in the world. There are Bible copies currently printed in over 750 languages (Shakespeare has been translated into 50 languages).



- † Pslams is the longest book in the Bible (150 Chapters).
- † 2 John is the shortest book in the Bible (1 Chapter with 13 Verses).
- † 3 John is close behind with 1 Chapter and 15 verses.
- † The longest verse in the Bible is Esther 8:9 with 70 words.
- † The shortest verse in the Bible is John 11:35 with 2 words ("Jesus wept.").
- † If you want a memory device to remember how many books there are in the Old Testament, take the number of letters in OLD (3) and put that together with the number of letters in TESTAMENT (9) and you come out with the correct answer of 39!
- † If you want a memory device to remember how many books are in the New Testament, take the number of letters in NEW (3) and multiply it by the number of letters in TESTAMENT (9) and you come out with the correct answer of 27!
