<b><u>LOCATION:</u></b>	Levite Jewish Community Center 3960 Montclair Rd Birmingham, AL 35213
<b><u>FACILITY:</u></b>	Indoor 6 lane, 25 yard with non-turbulent lane lines, Colorado Dolphin & Time Drops timing system. The competition course has NOT been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The water depth is a minimum of 3.5 feet to feet. Warm-up/warm-down lanes available at all times.
<b><u>RULES:</u></b>	<p>Current United States Swimming rules will govern the conduct of the meet. Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet. Southeastern Swimming safety guidelines and warm up procedures will be in effect.</p> <p>The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, locker rooms, or from behind the starting blocks. Deck changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or rest rooms is prohibited.</p> <p>In the interest of safety and accident prevention, coaches and swimmers are asked to observe all posted pool rules and facility rules referred to in this meet information and to conduct themselves in a safe and prudent manner. Birmingham Swim League will not accept responsibility for anyone who climbs to an unsafe height for any reason.</p> <p>Drones are prohibited over venues any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p> <p>No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 &amp; Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.</p> <p>1) A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette; or</li><li>2. Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips</li></ol>

<b><u>WARM-UPS:</u></b>	Session 1 - 12:30 to 12:55 PM Session 2 – 12:55 to 1:20 PM Southeastern Swimming safety guidelines and warm up procedures will be in effect.
<b><u>ELIGIBILITY:</u></b>	<p>All swimmers are welcome to participate in the meet. Athletes who are current and valid USA Swimming Registered athletes will have their times uploaded to the SWIMS database. USA registration number must be listed on the entry form. There will be no on-deck USA Swimming membership registration. Coaches and officials must present evidence of certification as required by Southeastern Swimming.</p> <p>A swimmer's age on the day of the meet will determine his or her age for the entire meet.</p> <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p>
<b><u>STARTING TIMES:</u></b>	Competition – 1:30 PM
<b><u>ENTRIES:</u></b>	<p>Entries must be emailed to <a href="mailto:chaz@sspro.info">chaz@sspro.info</a> by the deadline of <b>1:00 pm Saturday, March 7, 2026.</b></p> <p>All entries must be submitted via HyTek entry file. Teams who do not have their entries submitted by the deadline will only be allowed to swim in the meet at the discretion of the Meet Director and will be subject to deck entry in available lanes. Events will not be reseeded for late entries and new heats will not be created for late entries.</p> <p>Each club must print and sign the waiver of liability below. Waiver must be turned in before the start of the meet with team payment.</p>
<b><u>ENTRY DEADLINE:</u></b>	Entries must be emailed to <a href="mailto:chaz@sspro.info">chaz@sspro.info</a> as a HyTek entry file by 1:00 pm <b>Saturday, March 7, 2026.</b>
<b><u>FEES:</u></b>	<p>\$30.00 per individual swimmer \$2.50 per event</p> <p>Electronic Credit Card, Check and cash accepted. <b>One payment per club is preferred.</b> All entry fees are nonrefundable.</p> <p>Make checks payable <b>S&amp;S</b>. All check &amp; cash payments must be submitted to clerk of course at the computer table.</p>
<b><u>LIMITS:</u></b>	Each swimmer may enter a maximum of one (1) event per session and four (4) events total for the meet. Quadathlon(QM) events do not count towards swimmer's event total.

<p><b><u>MEET FORMAT:</u></b></p>	<p>This will be a timed finals meet.</p> <p>This is the second of the <b>Wave Series</b> timed finals meets taking place in January, March, May, and July. Point totals from this meet will be carried over and accumulated throughout the <b>Wave Series</b> of meets. Series high point winners will be awarded at the Tsunami Invitational in July.</p> <p><b>***Rumble Meet Format***</b></p> <p>All swimmers get four swims but may only swim each stroke once.</p> <p>Points shall be awarded for first through fifth place as follows: 6-4-3-2-1. High point awards will be given to boys &amp; girls in the following age groups: 6&amp;Under, 7&amp;8, 9&amp;10, 11&amp;12, 13&amp;14, 15&amp;Older.</p> <p>Because the <b>Wave Series</b> scores five events at each meet, the <b>Rumble Meet</b> will shake things up with the Aggregated Quadathlon Medley.</p> <p>Swimmers who select a different distance for each stroke will automatically have an aggregated Quadathlon Medley (QM) time generated as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 &amp; Under 200 QM - [25 + 100 + 50 + 25]</li> <li>• Open 375 QM - [200 + 100 + 50 + 25]</li> </ul> <p>Points will be awarded for the QM events as described above.</p> <p>Our goal is to encourage all swimmers to swim all strokes and try all distances by providing an opportunity for them to make informed strategic decisions about their event selection.</p> <p><b>SEEDING</b> – The meet will be seeded fastest to slowest by distance and time to allow for the most competitive races possible. Different strokes will be swum in the same heat. *Events 1/2 &amp; 3/4 will be seeded together with both distances.</p>
<p><b><u>ENTRY ERRORS:</u></b></p>	<p>A psych sheet and/or heat sheet will be emailed for review after the entry deadline. If there is an error, the swimmer will be deck-entered into an open lane of the heat nearest his/her entry time. The entire event will not be reseeded.</p>
<p><b><u>SCRATCHES/ PENALTIES:</u></b></p>	<p>All scratches should be submitted to the Clerk of Course by 1:10 pm the day of the competition. A swimmer may scratch a pre-seeded event on the block without penalty. A swimmer may not scratch from one event to enter another event.</p>
<p><b><u>VOLUNTEERS &amp; OFFICIALS:</u></b></p>	<p>The Block Party format allows for the USA Swimming certified coaches to act as stroke &amp; turn officials during this meet.</p> <p>Officials and apprentices from visiting teams are welcome and appreciated. Please contact the meet referee (<b>TBD</b>) with session(s) you are available to work. Dress in khaki pants/shorts/skirts, white shirts and white shoes. Please fill out information on “Team Information” page to be returned with entries. Officials must be members of USA Swimming and must present evidence of certification as required by Southeastern Swimming. Should there be any questions, meet officials will recognize only coaches or their designated representatives.</p> <p>Officials’ meeting will take place at the Starter’s Table 30 minutes before the start of the meet. Timers’ meeting will take place at Clerk of Course 15 minutes before the start of the meet.</p>

<p><b><u>SCORING/ AWARDS:</u></b></p>	<p>Points shall be awarded for first through fifth place as follows: 6-4-3-2-1. High point awards will be given to boys &amp; girls in the following age groups: 6&amp;Under, 7&amp;8, 9&amp;10, 11&amp;12, 13&amp;14, 15&amp;Older.</p> <p>Point totals from this meet will be carried over and accumulated throughout the “<b>Wave Series</b>” of meets. Series high point winners will be awarded at the Tsunami Invitational in July.</p>
<p><b><u>COACHES’ MEETING:</u></b></p>	<p>A coaches meeting will be held 10 minutes prior to the start of the meet at the computer desk.</p>
<p><b><u>RESULTS:</u></b></p>	<p>Un-Official live results will be posted in Meet Mobile.</p>

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**2026 Waiver, Acknowledgment, and Liability Release**
