With the help of the doctor, to get on the table.

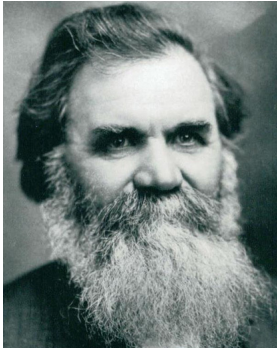
The doctor was gentle, without fuss or tussle
