Facility:

- Indoor Myrtha competition tank, 50 meters by 25 yards, 8 lanes, 2.5 meters per lane, uniform depth of 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters).
- Electronic timing and LCD scoreboard systems.
- Indoor 25-yard, 6-lane tank serves as the warmup pool, and has uniform depth of 4 feet.
- Indoor bleacher- style seating for 1,000 spectators
- Onsite parking for administrative personnel and officials.
- Bus parking available at adjacent Jacksons Travel Center Truck Stop.
- Parking for spectators, team vehicles, and buses is available via free street parking.

Entry Fees: \$30.00 Per Swimmer.

Eligibility:

All swimmers must be a member of a high school swim team.

Entry Information:

- **Team Event Limits:** There are no limits to the number of entries allowed per event.
- **Individual Event Limits:** Standard high school rules. Each swimmer may enter up to four (4) total events for the meet, but no more than two (2) individual events or three (3) relay events. To enter the 500 freestyle, swimmers must have a current season time that achieves a minimum qualifying standard (Women – 7:30.00; Men – 7:00.00)
- **Preliminary Heats:** All individual events will be pre-seeded with no penalty for a failure to show. Preliminary heats may be swum in two pools.
- **Finals Heats:** C, B, and A heats (bonus final, consolation final, and final). 500 freestyle limited to A & B heats. All Finals heats will be swum in the West tank.
- **Varsity & Junior Varsity:** There will be just one classification, with all swimmers eligible to compete and score as part of their team.
- **Scoring:** Top 16 individuals and Top 8 relays will score. Only two relays per team may qualify for finals for each relay event

Event Order: Standard High School event order will apply.

Invitation & Entries: All high school teams are invited to participate. The Entry file must be submitted no later than 6:00pm on Sunday, September 20, 2026. Entries should be submitted to Patty Stratton (tvhssmeetentrychair@gmail.com).
