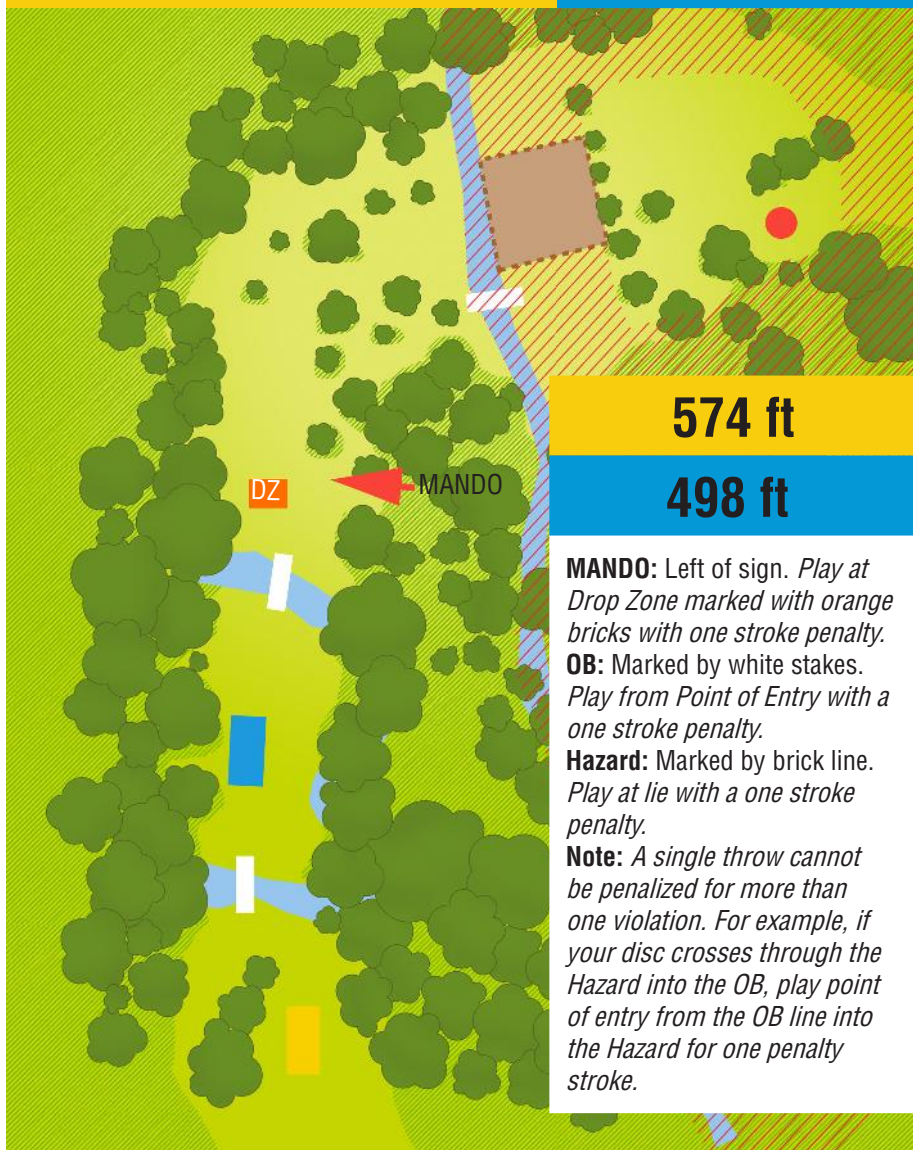
**ISLAND HOLE OB:**

1. If you miss the Island from the Gold/Blue teepad, play at Red teepad with a one stroke penalty
2. If you miss the Island from the Red teepad, play at Drop Zone marked with orange bricks with a one stroke penalty
3. If you miss the Island from the Drop Zone marked with orange bricks, play at Point of Entry with a one stroke penalty.
4. If your disc does not cross inbounds from the Drop Zone marked with orange bricks, play at Drop Zone marked with orange with a one stroke penalty.

**MANDO:** Left of sign. Play at Drop Zone marked with orange bricks with one stroke penalty.

**OB:** Marked by white stakes. Play from Point of Entry with a one stroke penalty.

**Hazard:** Marked by brick line. Play at lie with a one stroke penalty.

**Note:** A single throw cannot be penalized for more than one violation. For example, if your disc crosses through the Hazard into the OB, play point of entry from the OB line into the Hazard for one penalty stroke.
