PROCLAMATION KJD 2017-1

To: Worshipful Masters, Wardens, Past Masters and Brethren of all Subordinate Lodges of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Ohio, Free and Accepted Masons

Greetings:

In keeping with our ancient tradition adopted by the Prince Hall Free and Accepted Masons, we will pay tribute to Saint John the Evangelist, as one of our Patron Saints of Freemasonry.

Therefore, by the virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Grand Master of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Ohio, know ye that I, Kelvin J. Davis do hereby proclaim to all Brethren holding allegiance to this jurisdiction, that Saint John the Evangelist Day shall be solemnly observed on Sunday, December 17, 2017.

It is recommended that Lodges unite for a Public "District" Observance at a Lodge Hall, church or public place under the direction of the Deputy Lecturer of your District.

Take due and timely notice of the foregoing and govern yourselves accordingly.
