Carroll, do hereby proclaim that the 46thAnnual Grand Convocation will convene on Sunday, April 26, 2020, with devotion beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Holiday Inn, 4073 Medina Road, Akron, Ohio 44333, (330) 666-4131.
