All Knights Templar supplies, books and regalia will be handled by him. Those Sir Knights needing swords, chapeaus, hats, coats, belts, slings, crosses and manuals will be ordered through S.K. Johnson or the Eminent Grand Recorder S.K. Blair by way of your local recorder. All Knights Templar material will be purchased through the Grand Commandery. Sir Knight Johnson will have a price list of all items and he will be working with the Grand Recorder. A five percent markup will be included in our prices and will be placed into the Grand Commandery coffers. Sir Knight Johnson will be on constant lookout to obtain the best prices possible for our items from our vendors.

Finally, Sir Knights, I will need every Eminent Commander to improve his Commandery's performance and maintain that standard of operation. The Eminent Commander is responsible for everything that transpires within his Commandery. Therefore, the Past Eminent Commander's Degree will only be given to those Commanders that have fulfilled the following criteria: their Commandery has met and opened properly for at least 80% of the allotted meetings; they have paid their taxes to the current status; they have sent in their election results and returns; and most of their commandery officers have participated in all of the Grand Commandery functions. These things are nothing new but are expected.
