

Where can I get mental health support?

If you are having suicidal thoughts, need emergency mental health support, or are worried about someone else, call or text <u>988</u> to connect with a trained crisis counselor 24/7 at the <u>Suicide and Crisis Lifeline</u>. Additional crisis and non-emergency services are available in NJ.
