Arizona's School Surveillance Medication Program offers FREE online food allergy training and EpiPen's to schools

"Twenty-five percent of children have a first food allergy reaction at school," said Lisa Cohen, Founder and CEO of the Kyah Rayne Foundation. "The biggest barriers keeping schools from obtaining these simple, life-saving devices are: training and certification, and cost. We've effectively solved these challenges with this new program. Where there is food, there are food allergies. Help your school be safe with this life-saving medication that children with severe allergies depend on".

Kyah's EPICourse is promoted by the Arizona Department of Public Health and available to all public, private and charter schools in the state. Schools that want to access the EAIs will need to take a training course, developed by KRF, which will earn them the SSMP certification in accordance with state laws.

Ask SNOA

Dear SNOA,

If a nurse delegates a task to an unlicensed personnel (UAP) and the UAP makes an error is the nurse liable?

"If the delegating nurse followed all the acceptable practices of delegation ... and has documentation of those practices, the school nurse would have a defense for any allegations of improper delegation and supervision. If, however, the school nurse did not conduct a comprehensive assessment, provide adequate training, supervision, evaluation and documentation, both the school nurse and the delegatee would be responsible for the error (NCSBN & ANA)." (Resha, 2023, p 42)
