

# National Association of Christian Lawmakers NACL Model 2024-06 Coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud or abortioninducing drug

# Passed by the NALC-National Legislative Council Executive Committee by unanimous vote June 8, 2024

## Coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud

- (a) Coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud is committed when a person knowingly and intentionally engages in the use of an abortion-inducing drug on a pregnant woman, without her knowledge or consent, with the intent to cause an abortion.
- (b) (1) Except as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, whoever commits the crime of coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud shall be guilty of a class \_\_\_\_ felony.
  - (2) Whoever commits the crime of coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud when the unborn child is more than three months of gestational age shall be shall be guilty of a class \_\_\_\_ felony.
- (c) The prosecution of a person pursuant to this Section shall not be a defense against the prosecution under any other provision of law, including murder or attempted murder, should the person commit the crime of coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud and the use of an abortion-inducing drug results in the death or serious bodily injury of the pregnant woman.

### Criminal abortion by means of abortion-inducing drug

Composition of schedules

Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V shall, unless and until added pursuant to STATE law, consist of the following drugs or other substances, by whatever official name, common or usual name, chemical name, or brand name designated:

#### SCHEDULE IV

(a) Mifepristone, Misoprostol. Unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation containing any detectable quantity of mifepristone or misoprostol.

- (b) Prohibited acts--Schedule IV; penalties
  - (1) Possession. It is unlawful for any person knowingly or intentionally to possess a controlled dangerous substance classified in Schedule IV unless such substance was obtained directly or pursuant to a valid prescription or order from a practitioner, or as provided in STATE law, while acting in the course of his professional practice or except as otherwise authorized by this section. Any person who violates this Subsection with respect to:
    - (A) Flunitrazepam shall be guilty of a class \_\_\_\_ felony.
    - (B) Any other controlled dangerous substance shall be guilty of a class \_\_\_\_ felony.
- (2) It shall not be a violation of this Subsection for a pregnant woman to possess mifepristone or misoprostol for her own consumption.
  - (c) The Board of Pharmacy is directed to notify all pharmacists in STATE about the provisions of this law and that lawful prescriptions for mifepristone and misoprostol may be filled in accordance with STATE law.
  - (d) The Department of Health is directed to notify all healthcare practitioners and providers in STATE about the provisions of this law and that mifepristone and misoprostol may only be prescribed and administered in accordance with STATE law.
