We unequivocally condemn this heinous act of political violence in the strongest possible terms. Such an assault—aimed at a man of unwavering conviction—strikes not only at Charlie but at the very foundations of faith and discourse in our nation.

Charlie was more than a national leader—he was a true friend of NACL. In recognition of his steadfast witness, he was awarded the **American Patriot Award for Christian Honor & Courage** by the National Association of Christian Lawmakers. At last year's NACL Annual Meeting, Charlie delivered a stirring address that highlighted the cultural and political challenges facing Christians in America. He urged lawmakers and believers alike to remain steadfast in their faith and civic involvement, calling it a "worthy fight for the soul of America."
